between the parties: *Luster Products, Inc. v. Intimate Beauty Corporation and V Secret Catalogue, Inc.*, Case No. 05C-4527 in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division.

The following opposition proceedings, involving the same parties and some of the same questions of law and fact, are also presently suspended pending disposition of the same court case: Nos. 91167975; 91168059; 91169249; 91177359; 91177480; 91178596; 91178597; 91179153; 91179229; and 91179503.

In order to simplify the caption of this consolidated proceeding, the parties and the Board prospectively will list all involved proceedings in ascending order and refer to the parties as follows: Luster Products, Inc. v. V Secret Catalogue, Inc., Intimate Beauty Corporation, and Victoria's Secret Store Brand Management, Inc.⁴
