

**CONSENTED MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE PROCEEDINGS
AND TO EXTEND DISCOVERY AND TRIAL DATES**

Sara Lee DE/N.V. (“Applicant”), with the consent of Opposer Pumpnickel Associates, LLC, moves to (a) consolidate the nine above-captioned proceedings for purposes of trial and pre-trial proceedings and (b) extend discovery and all trial dates in the consolidated proceedings.

Applicant has applied for federal registration of the nine marks that are summarized below (“Applicant’s Marks”), all of which contain the design of a lady’s head (the “Lady’s Head Design”) and are for use in connection with coffee, tea, cocoa, and other beverages and machines used in the preparation of these beverages.


These oppositions involve common questions of law and fact. The Lady's Head Design in Applicant's Marks is substantially the same in each opposition, and Opposer is relying on the same registrations in each opposition. In view of the substantially identical alleged grounds for opposition in all nine pending proceedings, common questions of law or fact are involved in each proceeding. Therefore, pursuant to F.R.C.P. 42(a), Applicant, with the express consent of Opposer, requests that the Board approve consolidation of these proceedings.

In the event that this Consented Motion to Consolidate is granted, Applicant (again, with Opposer's express consent) requests that the discovery and testimony periods for these consolidated proceedings each be extended and set in accordance with the following dates:

Discovery period to close	December 29, 2003
30-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close	March 28, 2004
30-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close	May 27, 2004
15-day rebuttal testimony period for plaintiff to close	July 11, 2004




