It has come to the attention of the Board that, due to a clerical error by the Patent and Trademark Office, Trademark Registration No. 2777830 (application Serial No. 78081731), for the mark **UNITED STATES HISPANIC CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOUNDATION**, was inadvertently issued on October 28, 2003. The registration issued inadvertently after a different opposition involving the above application, Opposition No. 91156775, was dismissed and the application file forwarded to registration. The error is regretted.

Accordingly, the above-identified application will be forwarded to the Office of the Assistant Commissioner for Trademarks for appropriate action.<sup>1</sup>

The parties are advised, however, that the opposition proceeding will go forward in the usual manner and in accordance with the Trademark Rules of Practice, set forth in Title 37, part 2, of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Additionally, in that proceedings have resumed, an answer was due to the counterclaim (as last reset) on January 29, 2005. Inasmuch as it appears that no answer has been filed, nor has opposer/counterclaim defendant filed a motion to extend its time to respond, notice of default is hereby entered against opposer/counterclaim defendant under Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(a).

Opposer/counterclaim defendant is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to show cause why judgment by default should not be entered against opposer/counterclaim defendant in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(b).
