



**MOTION TO CONTINUE SUSPENSION**

On February 3, 2005 the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board suspended the captioned proceeding because the parties are negotiating for a possible settlement of the matter. The parties respectfully request that the suspension be extended for an additional six-month period through February 3, 2006.

This proceeding is one of several between the parties taking place in multiple jurisdictions throughout the world. Because of the necessity of bringing all such matters into a settlement agreement and further because the primary litigation in this matter is before a tribunal in the Philippines and there are substantial delays in obtaining rulings from that tribunal, it is in the interest of the parties and in the interest conserving scarce resources of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board to continue the suspension for an additional six-month period.

The parties request that said suspension be made subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time pursuant to Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

Further, in the event that neither party provides information concerning the progress of their negotiations, the parties request that the board issue as it deems fit an order resuming proceedings and resetting the trial date including the time for discovery.

Opposer's counsel, Christine L. Lofgren of Jeffer, Mangels, Butler & Marmaro, LLP consented to and joins in this motion. This motion is not for purposes of delay, but rather to allow the parties to continue to explore the possibility of settlement that if reached, would terminate this proceeding and preserve the Board's valuable resources. This motion is being submitted in triplicate.
