It has come to the Board's attention that opposer is involved in a civil proceeding, DC Comics. v. Kryptonite Corporation, No. 00 CV 5562.¹ Because this proceeding may have a dispositive effect on the Board proceeding, the Board proceeding is hereby suspended until there is a final disposition of the federal court action. 37 CFR § 2.117(a) and TBMP § 510.02 (2d ed. rev. 2004).

Within twenty days after the final determination of the civil action, the interested party should notify the Board so that this case may be called up for appropriate action.

During the suspension period, the Board should be notified of any address changes for the parties or their attorneys.
