On October 12, 2004, applicant filed a motion to suspend this proceeding pending the outcome of Opposition No. 91125739, as well as a motion to extend its time to file an answer.² On October 22, 2004, opposer filed a response thereto indicating that it consented to suspension.

In view thereof, applicant's motion to suspend the proceeding pending final determination of Opposition No. 91125739 is granted. See Trademark Rules 2.127(a) and 2.117(a).

Accordingly, proceedings are suspended pending final disposition of the opposition.

Within twenty days after the final determination of the opposition, the interested party should notify the Board so that this case may be called up for appropriate action. During the suspension period the Board should be notified of any address changes for the parties or their attorneys.
