On June 18, 2010, applicant filed an abandonment of its application Serial Nos. 78315569 and 78319291 with prejudice under Trademark Rule 2.68 with an allegation of opposer's "consent".

However, the applicable rule is Trademark Rule 2.135, which provides that if, in an inter partes proceeding, the applicant files an abandonment without the **written consent** of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against the applicant.

In view thereof, applicant is allowed **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order in which to submit opposer's written consent to the abandonment, failing which the opposition will be sustained and registration to applicant is refused.
