On June 29, 2005, the Board issued an order, *inter alia*, accepting the answer to the counterclaim filed by opposer and counterclaim defendant Gold Shells, Inc. It is noted, however, that the Board did not reset trial dates therein. Accordingly, trial dates, beginning with the close of discovery, are reset as indicated below.

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony, together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Testimony period for defendant in the counterclaim
and its rebuttal testimony as plaintiff in the
opposition to close: 4/28/06
(open for thirty days)

Rebuttal testimony period for plaintiff in the
counterclaim to close: 6/12/06
(open for fifteen days)

Briefs shall be due as follows:

Brief for plaintiff in the opposition shall be due: 8/11/06

Brief for defendant in the opposition and as
plaintiff in the counterclaim shall be due: 9/10/06

Brief for defendant in the counterclaim and its reply
brief (if any) as plaintiff in the opposition
shall be due: 10/10/06

Reply brief (if any) for plaintiff in the
counterclaim shall be due: 10/25/06

If the parties stipulate to any extension of these dates, the papers should be filed in triplicate and should set forth the dates in the format shown in this order. See Trademark Rule 2.121(d).

An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.
