NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Ms. Agnès Troublé ("Opposer") believes that she will be damaged by the registration of the trademark covered by Application Serial No. 78/345,428 (the "application") filed on December 24, 2003 by Bebe Studio, Inc. ("Applicant"), and hereby opposes the registration of the trademark.

Opposer is a citizen and resident of Paris, France with an address at 194, rue de Rivoli, 75001 Paris, France.

Applicant is, upon information and belief, a corporation whose address is 860 South Los Angeles Street, Room 600, Los Angeles, CA 90014.



Opposer has obtained the necessary extensions of time to file this Notice of Opposition and such Notice is timely made.

As grounds of Opposition, Opposer alleges as follows:

1. As illustrated in the Official Gazette dated October 12, 2004, at TM Page 399, Applicant seeks to register and use the trademark, "b" (stylized) and design, in International Class 25 for "clothing, namely, pants, jeans, trousers, shirts, blouses, jackets, shorts, and skirts" and has submitted an intent to use application.

2. Opposer is the owner of the following registered trademarks:

a. "b."(stylized)®, Registration No. 2,053,915, which was registered on the Principal Register on April 22, 1997 in International Class 25 for " articles of clothing, namely suits, coats, overcoats, rain coats, half coats, parkas, ties, shirts, jumpers, sweaters, underpants, jackets, tee-shirts, briefs, vests, socks, dresses, chasubles, skirts, cardigans, blouses, under shirts, polo shirts, petticoats, dungarees, overalls, boiler suits, brassiere, collars, cuffs, shawls, stocking, waistcoats, trousers, scarves, foulards, gloves, hats, caps, berets, pyjamas, dressing gowns, bathing costume, shoes, boots, sandals, slippers," and is in full force and effect and incontestable pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1065;

b. "b."(stylized)®, Registration No. 2,094,567, which was registered on the Principal Register on September 9, 1997 in International Class 14 for " precious metals and their alloys sold in bulk except those for dental use; jewelry; precious metals, namely, gold and silver; non-monetary coins of precious metals; medals; badges of precious metal; clocks; horological instruments for use as watches; watches; watch cases; watch bands; watch chains; watch parts, namely, springs and watch face glasses; wrist watches; chronographs for use as watches; chronometers," and is in full force and effect;

c. AGNES B. ®, Registration No. 1,336,761, which was registered on the Principal Register on May 21, 1985 in International Class 25 for "men's and women's ready to wear-namely, dresses, suits, skirts, jackets, coats for day and evening wear, for women; slacks, jackets, suits, sportshirts, dress-shirts, coats for day and evening wear, for men," and is in full force and effect and has been renewed pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1059;

d. AGNÈS B. (stylized) ®, Registration No. 1,719,758, which was registered on the Principal Register on September 29, 1992 in International Class 3 for "perfumes and cosmetics; namely, pencils and

shadows for eyelashes, eyelids and eyebrows; powders and creams for face makeup; creams, lotions and milks for removing face makeup; lipsticks; depilatory creams; creams and lotions for skin care; face packs; hair sprays; varnishes and varnish removers for nail care; salts, powders, oils for bath (non-medical use); toilet milks; creams, oils and lotions for skin; hair dyes; hair lotions; shampoos; toilet soaps; deodorants for personal use; toilet talc,” and in International Class 25 for “clothing, namely, men's, women's and children's suits,” and is in full force and effect and has been renewed pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1059;

e. SPORT B. FABRIQUÉ AU MAROC (stylized) ®, Registration No. 2,768,034, which was registered on the Principal Register on September 23, 2003, in International Class 25 for “belts, shoes, other than orthopedic shoes; head wear; sports clothing, namely, sweatpants, t-shirts, sweatshirts, shirts, shorts and tank tops” and is in full force and effect;

f. AGNÈS B. LAB' (stylized) ®, Registration No. 2,675,796, which was registered on the Principal Register on January 21, 2003 in International Class 25 for "clothing for men, women and children, namely, coats, overcoats, rain coats, parkas, t-shirts, jumpers, sweaters, underwear, vests, socks, dresses, skirts, suits, cardigans, blouses, undershirts, polo shirts, petticoats, brassieres, collars, cuffs, shawls, stockings, waistcoats, trousers, scarves, foulards, gloves, pajamas, dressing gowns, bathing suits, bath robes; footwear, namely, boots, shoes, sandals, slippers; headwear, namely, hats, caps and berets," and is in full force and effect and incontestable pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1065;

g. AGNÈS B. LOLITA (stylized) ®, Registration No. 1,708,281, which was registered on the Principal Register on August 18, 1992 in International Class 25 for “clothing; namely, shirts, T-shirts, dresses, skirts, slacks, raincoats, coats, suits, jackets, sport shirts, dress shirts,” and is in full force and effect and has been renewed pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1059;

h. AGNÈS B. SPORT (stylized) ®, Registration No. 2,758,199, which was registered on the Principal Register on September 2, 2003, in International Class 14 for “precious metals and their alloys sold in bulk, excluding those for dental use; jewelry; precious stones; gold and silver, namely, coffee and tea services, trays, napkin ringers, pitchers, picture frames and candlesticks, all made of precious metals; non-monetary coins of precious metals; medals; badges of precious metal; horological instruments, namely, clocks, alarm clocks and watches; watch cases; watch chains; watch bands,” in International Class 18 for “leather and imitation-leather articles, namely, animal skins, trunks and traveling bags; business card cases; calling card cases; credit card cases; vanity cases sold empty; briefcases; haversacks, handbags, garment bags for travel; valises and luggage; driving license cases; bandoliers, key cases,” and in International Class 25 for “clothing, namely, sweaters, shirts, pants, skirts, shorts, tank tops, sweat pants, sweatshirts and t-shirts; footwear other than

orthopedic shoes; gloves; belts; headwear,” and is in full force and effect;

i. SPORT B. (stylized) and Design®, Registration No. 2,804,042, which was registered on the Principal Register on January 13, 2004, in International Class 14 for “precious metals and their alloys sold in bulk, excluding those for dental use; jewelry; precious stones; gold and silver namely, coffee and tea services, trays, napkin ringers, pitchers, picture frames and candlesticks all made of precious metal; non-monetary coins of precious metals; medals; badges of precious metal; horological instruments, namely clocks, alarm clocks and watches; watch cases; watch chains; watch bands,” in International Class 18 for “leather and imitation-leather articles, namely, animal skins, trunks and traveling bags; purses; school bags; business card cases, calling card cases, credit card cases, vanity cases sold empty; briefcases; haversacks; handbags; garment bags for travel; valises and luggage; driving license cases; bandoliers; key cases,” and in International Class 25 for “clothing, namely, footwear other than orthopedic shoes; gloves; belts; headwear; sports clothing, namely sweaters, shirts, pants, skirts, shorts, tank tops, sweat pants, t-shirts, sweatshirts,” and is in full force and effect; and

j. SPORT B. AGNÈS B. (stylized) and Design®, Registration No. 2,896,538, which was registered on the Principal Register on October 26, 2004, in International Class 18 for “leather and imitation-leather articles, namely, animal skins, trunks and traveling bags; business card cases; calling card cases; credit card cases; vanity cases sold empty; briefcases; haversacks; handbags; garment bags for travel; valises and luggage; driving license cases; bandoliers; key cases,” and in International Class 14 for “precious metals and their alloys sold in bulk, excluding those for dental use; jewelry; precious stones; gold and silver, namely, coffee and tea services, trays, napkin ringers, pitchers, picture frames and candlesticks all made of precious metals; non-monetary coins of precious metals; medals; badges of precious metal; horological instruments, namely, clocks, alarm clocks and watches; watch cases; watch chains; watch bands,” and in International Class 25 for “footwear other than orthopedic shoes; gloves, belts; headwear; sports clothing, namely, sweaters, shirts, pants, skirts, shorts, tank tops, sweat pants, t-shirts, sweatshirts,” and is in full force and effect.

True and correct copies of the foregoing registered trademarks (the “Trademarks”) are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. The filing dates for Opposer's Trademarks long predate the application filing date of Applicant's alleged “b” (stylized) and Design trademark and no issue of priority

exists. Moreover, Opposer's dates of adoption and first use of its Trademarks long precedes the filing date of Applicant's intent to use application.

4. Since adoption and first use of its Trademarks, Opposer has used its Trademarks in substantially identical form in connection with the goods identified above and has continuously marketed and is presently marketing its goods under the Trademarks;

5. Since long before the date of filing of Applicant's application, Opposer has provided goods under the Trademarks in the United States, and Opposer is presently providing goods under the Trademarks in the United States. As a result, Opposer believes the public has come to recognize the Trademarks as originating from a single source.

6. By virtue of its promotional activities and the excellence of its goods, Opposer has gained a valuable reputation for its goods offered in association with its Trademarks, and has developed valuable goodwill with respect to its Trademarks.

7. Applicant's alleged "b" (stylized) and Design mark is substantially identical to Opposer's Trademarks, especially Opposer's two registered "b." stylized trademarks. Registration of the alleged "b" (stylized) and Design trademark will lead the public to incorrectly conclude that Applicant or its goods offered in connection with the alleged "b" (stylized) and Design trademark is or have been authorized, sponsored or licensed by Opposer. Accordingly, issuance of any registration to Applicant for the "b" (stylized) and Design trademark is contrary to the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d), and will result in damage to Opposer and the public.

8. Applicant's alleged "b" (stylized) and Design trademark is sufficiently similar to the Opposer's Trademarks in the terms used and the commercial impression it creates so as to cause confusion, to cause mistake or to deceive the public as to the origin of Applicant's goods bearing that trademark. Accordingly, registration of the alleged "b" (stylized) and Design

trademark is likely to cause confusion, to cause mistake or to deceive the public as to the origin of Applicant's goods displaying that trademark. Therefore, registration of said trademark is prohibited by 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

9. Registration of the alleged "b" (stylized) and Design trademark would constitute prima facie evidence of the validity of such Registration, of Applicant's ownership of that trademark, and of Applicant's exclusive right to use said trademark pursuant to the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 1057(b). Such registration would be a source of damage and injury to the Opposer and to the public and would be contrary to the principles of registration set out in 15 U.S.C. §1051 et seq.

10. Registration of the alleged "b" (stylized) and Design trademark would be incorrect and improper in view of the requirements of the Trademark Act of 1946, as amended, including specifically, but not limited to, the provisions of 15 U.S.C. §§ 1051, 1052 and 1127.

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained, and that registration to Applicant for the "b" (stylized) and Design trademark in International Class 25 be denied.

Opposer hereby files this Notice of Opposition in triplicate; enclosed herewith is Patterson, Belknap, Webb & Tyler Check No. 143456 in the amount of \$300.00 to cover the official government filing fee.

Opposer hereby appoints the firm of Patterson, Belknap, Webb & Tyler LLP, Gloria C. Phares and Stephanie B. Glaser, both members of the Bar of the State of New York, 1133 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York 10036, telephone number (212) 336-2000, its attorneys with full power of substitution and revocation, to prosecute this Opposition, and to transact all business in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office in connection with this Opposition.






