**OPPOSER'S MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY
RESPONSES BY APPLICANT**

Pursuant to 37 CFR §2.120(e), Opposer moves that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board compel supplemental and adequate response by Applicant to Opposer's discovery requests.

Opposer served Opposer's First Set of Interrogatories, and Opposer's First Set of Requests to Applicant for Production of Documents and Things, on Applicant on February 3, 2006. Copies of the Interrogatories and the Document Requests are attached as Exhibits 1 and 2. Applicant requested, and Opposer agreed to, an extension of the time for reply, and Applicant served its responses to the First Set of Interrogatories and the Responses to the First Set of Document Production Requests on April 10, 2006. Copies of the responses to the interrogatories are attached as Exhibit 3. Copies of the responses to document production requests are attached as Exhibit 4. Copies of all documents actually produced on April 10, 2006 are attached as Exhibit 5.



Some responses by Applicant indicated further information or documents would be forthcoming after a Protective Order was entered. The parties stipulated to a Protective Order and submitted it to the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board. The Board noted the filing of the stipulated Protective Order on May 30, 2006.

On July 10, 2006, Opposer sent Applicant a letter objecting to the adequacy of the discovery responses. A copy is attached as Exhibit 6. The letter points out that the produced copies of documents were not organized and did not appear to be responsive to all the requests, and that the responses to interrogatory no. 6 were not complete.

Over the next several months, Opposer attempted to get Applicant to supplement its response as requested in the July 10, 2006 letter, and was regularly assured that a further response would be forthcoming. Opposer did eventually receive a second batch of document copies with a cover letter dated February 21, 2007 (copies of the letter and documents are attached as Exhibit 7). No supplemental responses to interrogatories were provided. The cover letter simply states that the documents were produced "as they are kept in the usual course of business" but that appears to be a euphemism for no organization of the documents at all.

Opposer finds the following deficiencies in Applicant's response to discovery requests.

Applicant has not answered Interrogatory No. 6 adequately. Applicant has not described the dates of use of its mark for each of the products listed in its application, instead giving a general "since 1999." This is especially unsatisfactory since the application being opposed is an "intent-to-use" application. Applicant should be compelled to state the dates of use of its mark for each of the products listed in its trademark application.

Applicant refused to produce information about sales figures in response to Interrogatory No. 6(f), or to produce related documents in response to Document Request No. 5, on the ground that no protective order was then in place. The Protective Order was entered on May 30, 2006. Applicant should be compelled to fully answer Interrogatory No. 6(f) and produce documents responsive to Request No. 5.

A review of the documents that have been produced by Applicant (Exhibits 5 and 7) shows that they consist of drawings or representations of various clothing articles or labels bearing the mark PF. They are not dated, and there is no indication that actual production or sales of any of the items ever occurred. The documents do not carry out Applicant's promise, in its written response to Document Request No. 1, that "responsive documents sufficient to

establish the nature, extent, and duration of Applicant's use of its PF trademark will be produced." This same promise was made in responses to Document Requests Nos. 4 and 6. Applicant should be compelled to produce documents "sufficient to establish the nature, extent and duration of Applicant's use of its PF trademark."

In response to Interrogatory No. 11 directed to trademark searches, Applicant responds that "Applicant's trademark counsel, Ezra Sutton, P.A., conducted a search on behalf of Applicant prior to the filing of Application No. 76/575,509." Document Request No. 7 asks for documents related to that search, which clearly includes the search results, which are discoverable subject matter. Applicant promised to produce "non-privileged responsive documents." It has not. Applicant should be compelled to produce any trademark search results, including any it can recover from its counsel, Mr. Sutton.

It is over a year since Opposer has served its discovery requests on Applicant. Opposer deserves complete responses, and Applicant should be compelled to give them.

Opposer, through its attorney, has made a good faith effort, by correspondence, to resolve with Applicant's attorney the issues presented in this motion, and been unable to reach agreement, as seen by the responses it has recently received.

Trading, Inc., answer under oath the following interrogatories within thirty days after service of such interrogatories.

INTERROGATORIES

2. Identify each and every place of business maintained by Applicant in the United States, its territories, and/or possessions.
3. Identify the officers of Applicant.
4. Identify any and all affiliates or partners of Applicant.
5. Identify and any all officers of any affiliates or partners of Applicant.
6. For each different type of product or service offered by Applicant, or partner or any Affiliate, in the United States, with which the Applicant, or partner or any Affiliate, currently uses or plans to use the mark PF:
 - a. identify each product or service by supplying its generic name;

- b. state in detail how each product or service is marketed, or is planned to be marketed, by or for Applicant or any Affiliate;
 - c. identify current or planned marketing channels for each product or service;
 - d. identify the class of customers to whom Applicant or any Affiliate offers or sells, or plans to offer or sell, each product or service;
 - e. give the inclusive dates during which Applicant or any Affiliate has offered or sold each product or service in the United States, if such offers or sales have occurred;
 - f. provide the annual sales figures of each product or service from the date of first use of the mark "PF" in the United States on or in association with each product or service, if any such sales have occurred;
 - g. identify all documents that refer or relate to any of the information requested in this interrogatory; and
 - h. identify in the answers given above, which information relates to Applicant and which information relates to any Affiliates of Applicant.
7. Describe the basis, if any, upon which Applicant intends to file a Statement of Use in trademark application serial no. 76/575,509 that it has used the mark, and how Applicant has controlled, or plans to control, the quality of the goods provided by Applicant.
8. Describe in detail each and every way in which Applicant has made use of the mark PF, including the manner in which the mark is used (if it has been used) in relation to the products named in the application serial no. 76/575,509, and identify all documents evidencing each different use, and give the inclusive dates of each such different use.

9. Identify each and every print (including newspaper, magazine, periodical), television and radio advertisement in which the mark PF was or is intended to be used by Applicant, or any Affiliates, in connection with Applicant's products or services, and as to each such print, television, or radio advertisement, state the date(s) on which, and locations in which, such advertisement was run, or will be, run.
10. Describe fully and in detail the circumstances surrounding Applicant's development and selection of the mark PF, identify all persons with knowledge as to the same, and identify all documents constituting, memorializing, referring or relating to such development and selection.
11. Identify each and every investigation conducted by or on behalf of Applicant in connection with the mark PF to determine the availability thereof as a trademark, to determine the registrability thereof as a trademark, to determine the extent to which others may be using the same or similar terms, or for any other reason, and for each investigation state:
 - a. the date the investigation was completed;
 - b. the identity of each person conducting the investigation;
 - c. the identity of each person receiving the report of the investigation;
 - d. the identity of all documents referring or relating to the investigation; and
 - e. the identity of all third party marks and their uses disclosed by the investigation.
12. State whether or not Applicant, or any Affiliates, is now or ever has been involved in any U.S. Patent & Trademark proceeding (including any oppositions, cancellations, or refusals to register by a Trademark Office Examining Attorney) which involves, relates to, or may affect Applicant's use and/or ownership, if any, or Applicant's intent to

1. 8. As used herein, the term "third party" means any person or entity other than Opposer and Applicant.
9. As used herein, the term "trademark" or "mark" means any words or symbols used by either party to identify the source of their respective products, or their services, or their respective corporate identities.

10. As used herein, the term "Opposer's marks" means the mark identified by the Opposer as PF, and registered in U.S. Trademark Registrations numbered 429,057 and 1,236,457 and any other mark the Opposer will rely on in this proceeding.
11. As used herein, the term "Applicant's mark" means the mark PF as shown in Applicant's Trademark Application No. 76/575,509.
12. As used herein, the term "Notice of Opposition" means the Notice of Opposition filed by the Opposer and identified with the Opposition No. 91165451.

The application that is the subject of the opposition is an intent-to-use application. For at least some of the products listed in the application, presumably use did not begin in 1999. The interrogatory clearly asked for dates (and, in 6(f), sales figures) for "each product" (preferably as listed in the application) so that the history and extent of use of the PF mark on each product is revealed. Please provide that information.

Since the discovery period is presently scheduled to close August 16, and we are obviously still completing discovery, I request your consent to a three-month extension of the trial dates.
