Opposer's motion (filed February 10, 2006) to suspend the proceeding pending final determination of a civil action between the parties is hereby granted in view of applicant's response (filed March 9, 2006) consenting to the suspension.<sup>1</sup>

action. During the suspension period the Board should be notified of any address changes for the parties or their attorneys.
