ANSWER

To the Honorable Commissioner of Trademarks:

In the matter of the Nano-Write Corporation (hereinafter called "Opposer") opposition to registration of the trademark NANO-CERAM, application serial no. 78/425,501, as applied for by Bio-CAM, LC, a Florida Limited Liability Company with offices in West Palm Beach, Florida (hereinafter called "Applicant"), Applicant answers as follows:


1. Applicant admits that the Opposer offers dental fabricating services which services, identified by the mark NANO-TICROWN, are titanium (abbreviated Ti in the Periodic Table of Elements is a grey-color metal) dental copings and completed porcelain-fused-to-titanium crowns, which copings and crowns are processed by means of CAD/CAM automated vapor deposition technologies. Applicant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the remaining allegations in paragraph one (1) of the Opposer's Notice of Opposition.



2. Applicant admits that the Opposer offers fabricated dental products which products, identified by the mark NANO-TICROWN, are titanium dental copings and completed porcelain-fused-to-titanium crowns, which copings and crowns are processed by means of CAD/CAM automated vapor deposition technologies. Applicant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the remaining allegations in paragraph two (2) of the Opposer's Notice of Opposition.
3. Applicant admits that the Opposer has registered its trademark NANO-TICROWN, for dental restorative devices, which devices are sometimes called dental appliances. Applicant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the remaining allegations in paragraph three (3) of the Opposer's Notice of Opposition.
4. Applicant denies that the mark NANO-TICROWN which mark identifies porcelain-fused-to-titanium and titanium dental restorations, and the mark NANO-CERAM which mark identifies metal-free all-ceramic dental restorations, could cause confusion or cause mistake or deceive purchasers, which purchasers are licensed dentists and dental laboratories.
5. Applicant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the remaining allegations in paragraph five (5) of the Opposer's Notice of Opposition.






