**NOTICE OF OPPOSITION**

In the matter of application for registration of the trademark HANDS ON FUN! AND DESIGN for a variety of goods and services in classes 15, 16, 28 and 35, Serial No. 76/586,885 filed on April 15, 2004 by Oriental Trading Company, Inc. of Omaha, Nebraska, which trademark was published for opposition in the Official Gazette dated November 1, 2005.

Fibre-Craft Materials Corp., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, and having a place of business at 6310 West Touhy Avenue, Niles, Illinois 60714, believes it will be damaged by the registration of the above-identified trademark.

THE GROUNDS OF OPPOSITION ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Opposer is the owner of the following trademark registrations, which are now in full force and effect.

Registration No. 2,342,740 registered on April 18, 2000 for the mark CREATIVE HANDS for household glue for decorative purposes; wooden craft sticks and spoons; plastic eyes, chenille passementerie, pom poms; and arts and crafts kits for making toys and decorative items.

Registration No. 2,530,660 registered on January 15, 2002 for the mark CREATIVE HANDS AND DESIGN for wooden craft sticks and spoons; plastic eyes, chenille passementerie, pom poms; and arts and crafts kits for making toys, decorative items and foam shapes.

Registration No. 2,543,523 registered on February 26, 2002 for the mark CREATIVE HANDS AND DESIGN for household glue for decorative purposes.

Registration No. 2,871,354 registered on August 10, 2004 for the mark CREATIVE HANDS AND DESIGN for magnets; charms and gemstones; modeling clay, arts and crafts paint, and wind chime painting kits; foam shapes, foam sheets, foam stickers, glitter, picture frames and door hangers; and feathers, plastic beads, glass beads and metallic beads.

Registration No. 2,871,355 registered on August 10, 2004 for the mark CREATIVE HANDS for magnets charms and gemstones; modeling clay, arts and crafts paint, and wind chime painting kits; foam shapes, foam sheets, foam stickers, glitter, picture frames and door hangers; and feathers, plastic beads, glass beads and metallic beads.

Registration No. 2,909,953 registered on December 14, 2004 for the mark DO FUN! for household glue for decorative purposes, stickers, modeling clay, arts and crafts paint and wind chime painting kit; foam shapes, foam sheets, foam stickers, glitter, picture frames, and door hangers; plastic eyes, chenille passementerie, pom poms, laces and hooks, feathers, plastic beads, glass beads and metallic beads; and arts and crafts kits for making toys, decorative items and foam shapes and confetti.

Registration No. 2,941,212 registered on April 19, 2005 for the mark DO FUN! AND DESIGN for household glue for decorative purposes, stickers,

modeling clay, arts and crafts paint and wind chime painting kit; foam shapes, foam sheets, foam stickers, glitter, picture frames, and door hangers; plastic eyes, chenille passementerie, pom poms, laces and hooks, feathers, plastic beads, glass beads and metallic beads; and arts and crafts kits for making toys, decorative items and foam shapes and confetti.

2. Since at least 1992, Opposer has been using the trademark CREATIVE HANDS to identify various goods that it sells in interstate commerce. The CREATIVE HANDS trademark is used on packaging for products, on advertising literature and in other manners customary to the trade.

3. Since at least 1998, Opposer has been using the CREATIVE HANDS Logo to identify various goods that it sells in interstate commerce. The CREATIVE HANDS Logo is used on packaging for products, on advertising literature and in other manners customary to the trade.

4. Since at least as early as January, 2003, Opposer has been using the trademark DO FUN! and its distinctive DO FUN! Logo to identify goods that it sells in interstate commerce. The DO FUN! trademark and logo is used on packaging for products, on advertising literature and in other manners customary to the trade.

5. Since long prior to May 8, 2003, Opposer has built up and is now maintaining a substantial and valuable business throughout the United States in the sale of various products for use in the arts and crafts industry, which products are identified by Opposer's trademarks CREATIVE HANDS, DO FUN! and their respective logos displayed in various forms, including the forms

shown in the registrations listed in paragraph 1 herein. Opposer's trademarks are prominently displayed on Opposer's goods, by printing them on packaging for the goods and by affixing them to containers for the goods. Opposer's trademarks are also prominently displayed on advertising material, descriptive literature, product brochures and on Opposer's internet website. Opposer's trademarks have been brought to the attention of the purchasing public, including Opposer's customers, so prominently and repeatedly as to become well and favorably known as identifying Opposer's goods.

6. Opposer sells goods identified by its CREATIVE HANDS and DO FUN! trademarks and logos to a wide variety of customers including to distributors and retailers for resale to the consuming public. Opposer also sells products identified by its CREATIVE HANDS and DO FUN! trademarks and logos through its internet website, namely, [www.fibrecraft.com](http://www.fibrecraft.com).

7. Opposer has expended considerable time, effort and money advertising and publicizing the sale of products identified by its CREATIVE HANDS and DO FUN! trademarks and logos.

8. As a result of Opposer's long and successful use of its CREATIVE HANDS and DO FUN! trademarks and logos, these trademarks have come to identify Opposer's products and services and to represent substantial goodwill belonging to Opposer.

9. By the application herein opposed, Applicant seeks to register the HANDS ON FUN! AND DESIGN. The application was filed in conjunction with a variety of goods and services in classes 15, 16, 28 and 35.

10. Upon information and belief, Applicant uses the HANDS ON FUN logo in connection with a variety of arts and crafts products, which products are in direct competition with the products being sold by Opposer under its CREATIVE HANDS and DO FUN! trademarks and logos. In many instances, the goods of Opposer and Applicant are identical. Opposer submits that Applicant's use of the HANDS ON FUN logo on these goods will unquestionably be likely to cause confusion, mistake, or deception in the minds of the purchasing public.

11. Opposer submits that Applicant created its HANDS ON FUN logo by taking portions of Opposer's CREATIVE HANDS logo and portions of Opposer's DO FUN! logo and combined them to make a mark that is so similar to Opposer's trademarks as to be likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception in the minds of the purchasing public. The font style for Applicant's HANDS ON FUN logo is the same as Opposer's font style for its DO FUN! logo.

12. The products identified by Applicant in its application are being offered and sold in the same channels of trade as are the products being sold by Opposer identified by its marks CREATIVE HANDS, DO FUN! and related logos.

13. The products identified by Applicant in its application are being sold to the same class of customers as those customers who purchase goods sold by Opposer identified by its marks CREATIVE HANDS, DO FUN! and related logos.

14. Registration by Applicant of the HANDS ON FUN logo for the products set forth in said application will lead to confusion by the public as

between Applicant's and Opposer's respective products or the sources thereof and the public, which is familiar with Opposer's products and its registered trademarks and is likely to be confused, with consequent injury to Opposer and the public.

15. Still further, Applicant is not entitled to register the HANDS ON FUN logo for the products set out in said application, because registration, of the mark Applicant, will presumptively confer upon Applicant *prima facie* exclusive ownership rights to the same products in the same filed to which Opposer as long since been engaged, in violation and derogation of the prior and superior rights of Opposer.

16. Registration should also be refused because Applicant's use of the HANDS ON FUN logo will falsely suggest a connection between Applicant and Opposer named herein, to the damage of Opposer.

17. A copy of each registration set forth in paragraph 1 is attached hereto and identified as Exhibit A.

18. Pursuant to Section 31 of the Trademark Act, Opposer requests the TTAB to charge the deposit of these charges, namely Deposit Account #22-0259 in the amount of \$1200.00 to cover the cost of the filing of this Opposition.

WHEREFORE, Opposer believes that it will be damaged in the manner set forth above, and otherwise, if the Applicant, Oriental Trading Company, Inc. is allowed to register its HANDS ON FUN logo for the products in classes 15, 16, 28 and 35 as set forth in its application and respectfully requests that registration of the above-identified mark of Applicant be denied.
