

**MOTION BY APPLICANT TO CONSOLIDATE OPPOSITIONS
WITH CONSENT OF OPPOSER**

Applicant, Oriental Trading Company, Inc., by its undersigned counsel, hereby moves pursuant to 37 CFR §2.116 and Rule 42 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure to consolidate Opposition No. 91168399 (HANDS ON FUN and Design mark) with Opposition No. 91168419 (HANDS ON FUN and Palette Design mark).

The discovery and trial periods in both oppositions set by the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board are within one day of each other.

STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF MOTION

Opposition No. 91168399 was filed by Opposer against Applicant's Trademark Application Serial No. 76/586885 for the mark HANDS ON FUN and Design. Opposition No. 91168419 was filed by Opposer against Applicant's Trademark Application Serial No. 76/586891 for the mark HANDS ON FUN and Palette Design. Both applications are for the same goods and services.

Both oppositions involve the same parties. Opposer, Fibre-Craft Materials Corp., and

Applicant, Oriental Trading Company, Inc., are each represented by the same counsel in each case.

Rule 42 permits the Board to consolidate actions which involve a common question of law or fact and to issue orders in such actions which tend to avoid unnecessary costs and delay. In both oppositions, Opposer has raised the issue of likelihood of confusion of Opposer's marks with Applicant's marks. Both oppositions are based on the same trademarks registered by Opposer. The only difference between the oppositions is that the mark in Applicant's Application Serial No. 76/586891 contains an additional background design of an artist's palette, which Applicant contends is a further distinguishing feature.

It is anticipated that the trials of these oppositions will require the presentation of the same or substantially similar evidence relating to the issue of likelihood of confusion, and the use of the marks.

Further, the discovery in both oppositions will focus on the same or similar questions and documents. Thus, consolidation of the oppositions will avoid unnecessary duplication of effort and expense by the parties.

Accordingly, Opposer requests the Board to issue an order consolidating the oppositions and resetting the discovery and trial dates in Opposition No. 91168399 to coincide with the dates set by the Board in Opposition No. 91168419 as indicated below. There is presently only one day difference between the two schedules.

Discovery period to close:	July 24, 2006
30-day testimony period for Plaintiff to close:	October 22, 2006
30-day testimony period for Defendant to close:	December 21, 2006


