Since long prior to Applicant's application filing date of January 5, 2005, Opposer has used one or more of a series of marks that feature the BAND-AID® mark by itself or in combination with other words and/or design elements to identify a variety of its medical, medicinal, therapeutic and personal care products and other products and services.

4. Opposer is the owner of:

- a) Reg. No. 194,123 - BAND-AID for protective surgical dressing in the form of a bandage; registered January 13, 1925. The registration is incontestable and alleges use since November 1920.
- b) Reg. No. 2,107,863 - BAND-AID BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES RACING & Design for bandages and dressing for skin wounds; printed matter, namely, note paper, posters, artist prints, stationery-type portfolios, paper banners, newsletters, and press releases, all relating to auto racing events; trading cards; playing cards; clothing, namely, hats, caps, shirts, jackets, pants, vests, and shorts; toy cars and toy trucks; model cars and model trucks; race toss game; golf balls; advertising and promoting racing car events of others; entertainment services, namely, competing in automobile races for the entertainment of viewers; registered October 21, 1997. The registration is incontestable and alleges use since October 1996.
- c) Reg. No. 2,304,615 - BAND-AID ANTIBIOTIC BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES ANTIBIOTIC OINTMENT JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered December 28, 1999, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- d) Reg. No. 2,317,050 - BAND-AID WATER BLOCK PLUS ADHESIVE BANDAGES SHIELDS OUT WATER AND GERMS JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered February 8, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- e) Reg. No. 2,322,201 - BAND-AID for hot/cold gel pack for applying hot or cold therapy; registered February 22, 2000, alleging use since January 18, 1999.
- f) Reg. No. 2,373,302 - BAND-AID FLEXIBLE FABRIC BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES FLEXIBLE PROTECTION JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered August 1, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.

- g) Reg. No. 2,373,303 - BAND-AID ADHESIVE BANDAGES SHEER EXTRA LARGE WOUND PROTECTION JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered August 1, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- h) Reg. No. 2,377,901 - BAND-AID SPORT STRIP BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES CUSHIONED COMFORT JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered August 15, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- i) Reg. No. 2,377,902 - BAND-AID BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES SHEER BREATHABLE PROTECTION JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered August 15, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- j) Reg. No. 2,383,619 - BAND-AID PLASTIC BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES DURABLE PROTECTION JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered September 5, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- k) Reg. No. 2,383,620 - BAND-AID SHEER BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES BREATHABLE PROTECTION JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered September 5, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- l) Reg. No. 2,402,353 - BAND-AID BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered November 7, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- m) Reg. No. 2,402,354 - BAND-Am FOR SENSITIVE SKIN BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES GENTLE REMOVAL WITH VITAMIN E JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered November 7, 2000, alleging use since November 18, 1998.
- n) Reg. No. 2,471,737 - BAND-AID for non-medicated soothing foot gel preparations; calamine and anti-itch preparations; first aid antibiotic and pain relief preparations for wounds; a full line of foot care products namely, self-adhering corn, callus, bunion and blister pads, cushions, and patches; registered July 24, 2001, alleging use since January 15, 1998.
- o) Reg. No. 2,517,015 - BAND-AID BRAND ADHESIVE BANDAGES ADVANCED HEALING JOHNSON & JOHNSON & Design for adhesive bandages; registered December 11, 2001, alleging use since 1999.

A copy of each registration is attached hereto as Exhibits A-O.

5. Opposer's BAND-AID® marks are famous as an indicator of source and origin as a result of the marks' long use in connection with the goods and services identified in the registrations listed above.

6. Over the years, Opposer has sold many millions of dollars worth of products under the BAND-AID® mark, and marks comprised of the BAND-AID® mark, to Opposer's institutional customers, Opposer's distributors, Opposer's retail store customers, and to the general public.

7. Opposer has extensively advertised its marks for or featuring the BAND-AID® mark to the trade and to the general public throughout all available media, including but not limited to national print publications, broadcast and cable television media, and point-of-sale advertising in regional and national retailers, including mass merchants and via the Internet.

8. By virtue of its extensive sales and promotion, Opposer's marks for or featuring the BAND-AID® mark have become famous in the trade and to the general public, and have acquired a high degree of distinctiveness indicating source in Opposer.

9. Opposer has continuously used the trademarks LIQUID BANDAGE & Drop Design® and LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® since as early as February 6, 2002 in connection with waterproof wound dressings.

10. Opposer is the owner of Reg. No. 2,851,484 – LIQUID BANDAGE & Drop Design for waterproof wound dressing; registered June 8, 2004, and Reg. No. 2,856,420 – LIQUID BANDAGE & Design for waterproof wound dressing; registered June 22, 2004, both alleging use since February 6, 2002 (the “LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks”). A copy of each registration is enclosed as Exhibits P-Q.

11. Opposer is using the LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks in conjunction with its BAND-AID® mark. A copy of the packaging for Applicant's BAND-AID® LIQUID BANDAGE product is enclosed as Exhibit R.

12. On information and belief, Applicant had not used the mark LIQUIDBOND+AID in interstate commerce in connection with the goods identified in application Ser. No. 78/542,447 as of the January 5, 2005 filing date of the application.

13. On information and belief, Applicant has never used the mark LIQUIDBOND+AID in interstate commerce in connection with the goods identified in application Ser. No. 78/542,447.

14. The BOND+AID portion of Applicant's LIQUIDBOND+AID mark is virtually identical to Opposer's BAND-AID® mark in appearance, sound and connotation differing by only one letter.

15. Opposer's LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks and Applicant's LIQUIDBOND+AID mark are substantially similar in appearance, sound and connotation.

16. On information and belief, the goods and services on which Opposer uses the BAND-AID® and LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks and the goods for which Applicant intends to use the LIQUIDBOND+AID mark are identical.

17. On information and belief, the goods and services on which Opposer uses the BAND-AID® and LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks and the goods for which Applicant intends to use the LIQUIDBOND+AID mark may be sold or rendered through the same channels of trade.

18. On information and belief, the goods and services on which Opposer uses the BAND-AID® and LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks and the goods for which Applicant

intends to use the LIQUIDBOND+AID mark may be sold or rendered to the same class of purchasers.


19. The use and registration by Applicant of the LIQUIDBOND+AID mark for the goods identified in Ser. No. 78/542,447 are likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception by having the public erroneously assume or believe that the goods emanate from Opposer, or are in some other way associated or connected with Opposer's prior used BAND-AID® and LIQUID BANDAGE & Design® marks, all to Opposer's irreparable damage.

20. Applicant's mark LIQUIDBOND+AID, which is virtually identical or highly similar to BAND-AID®, constitutes a dilution of Opposer's marks for or featuring the BAND-AID® mark in violation of Lanham Act Section 43(c), 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).

For the reasons set forth in paragraphs 1-20, Opposer believes and believing asserts that it will be damaged by the registration of Ser. No. 78/542,447 – LIQUIDBOND+AID. Accordingly, Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained, and that Applicant be refused registration of the LIQUIDBOND+AID mark for the goods set forth in application Ser. No. 78/542,447.
