Opposer's consented motion for suspension (filed October 24, 2008) is granted.

Because the parties are negotiating for a possible settlement of this case, proceedings herein are suspended until **November 24, 2008**, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations within the next six months, the Board will issue an order resuming proceedings and resetting trial dates, commencing with plaintiff's testimony period.

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set out below.

THE PERIOD FOR DISCOVERY TO CLOSE: CLOSED

30-day testimony period for plaintiff in the opposition to close: January 23, 2009

30-day testimony period for defendant in the opposition and as plaintiff in the counterclaim to close: March 24, 2009

30-day testimony period for defendant in the counterclaim and its rebuttal testimony as plaintiff in the opposition to close: May 23, 2009

15-day rebuttal testimony period for plaintiff in the counterclaim to close: July 7, 2009

Briefs shall be due as follows:

Brief for plaintiff in the opposition shall be due: September 5, 2009

Brief for defendant in the opposition and as plaintiff in the counterclaim shall be due: October 5, 2009

Brief for defendant in the counterclaim and its reply brief (if any) as plaintiff in the opposition shall be due: November 4, 2009

Reply brief (if any) for plaintiff in the counterclaim shall be due: November 19, 2009

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.

NEWS FROM THE TTAB:

The USPTO published a notice of final rulemaking in the Federal Register on August 1, 2007, at 72 F.R. 42242. By this notice, various rules governing Trademark Trial and Appeal Board inter partes proceedings are amended. Certain amendments have an effective date of August 31, 2007, while most have an effective date of November 1, 2007.
