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OPPOSER'S NOTICE OF RELIANCE NO. 1 UNDER 37 CFR § 2.122(d)(2)

H-D Michigan, Inc. ("Opposer") submits of record in connection with this opposition proceeding, status and title copies of the United States Trademark Registrations that it intends to rely on in this case. A complete list of Opposer's registrations is set forth in the chart below. Status and title copies of the registrations prepared and issued by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office are attached as Exhibits 1 to 63.

These registrations are relevant to the above-noted opposition proceeding because they establish, among other things, that Opposer is the owner of over 63 valid and subsisting prior registrations for marks that are substantially similar to the mark at issue in this proceeding. Opposer will rely on these registrations to show that it has priority under *King Candy Co. v. Eunice King's Kitchen, Inc.*, 496 F.2d 1400, 182 USPQ 108 (CCPA 1974). Additionally, Opposer will rely upon these registrations to establish, among other things, the scope of Opposer's prior rights in its HARLEY, HARLEY-DAVIDSON, and BAR & SHIELD Logo marks in connection with goods and services that are closely related to those identified in the subject application.
