MOTION TO EXTEND DISCOVERY AND TESTIMONY PERIODS
PURSUANT TO TRADEMARK RULE 2.121(a)(1)**

Applicant, CHARMAINE V. JONES, pursuant to Trademark Rule 2.121(a)(1), 37 C.F.R. §2.121(a)(1), with the consent of Opposer, CAKE DIVAS, hereby seeks to amend its Motion For Suspension filed today, February 27, 2008, to a Motion to Extend Discovery and Testimony Periods, and as such moves for an order rescheduling the discovery and testimony periods 90 days after the dates ordered by the Board on November 20, 2007.

This extension and rescheduling is necessary to enable the parties to complete settlement discussions. Such an extension will not prejudice either party and will not unduly delay the proceedings.

Pursuant to this rescheduling, the discovery and testimony periods should be reset as follows:

Fifteen-day rebuttal testimony period to close	December 10, 2008


Briefs will be filed thereafter in accordance with Rule 2.128(a) and (b).




