**APPLICANT'S MOTION TO EXTEND  
TIME TO ANSWER OPPOSITION**

Applicant, ALBAUGH, INCORPORATED, hereby requests a thirty (30) day extension of time from December 31, 2006, to January 31, 2008, to answer the above identified Opposition.

1. Opposer filed its opposition on November 20, 2007, and notice of the time to answer was mailed to Applicant on November 21, 2007.
2. The forty (40) day period to respond to the opposition ends December 31, 2007.
3. Applicant is requesting a thirty (30) day extension extending the time to respond from December 31, 2007, to January 31, 2008.
4. On December 17, 2007, Applicant's attorney Adam W. Jones spoke with Opposer's counsel Joyce Ferraro, and Ms. Ferraro agreed to the requested thirty (30) day extension requested herein.
5. Since December 7, 2007, representatives of Applicant had been in discussion with representatives of Opposer concerning possible settlement and avoidance of an opposition proceeding. These discussion were unavoidably hampered by the holidays.

7. Applicant needs the extra thirty (30) days in order for the parties to have time to meaningfully discuss settlement both between counsel and internally among corporate decision makers.

8. Applicant believes that the requested extension of thirty (30) days will be sufficient to provide adequate time for the parties to negotiate settlement and that such extension will not unduly delay these proceedings and/or prejudice Opposer.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the TTAB grant this motion to extend.
