On 12 February 2010, StonCor, the opposer in this trademark opposition proceeding, filed a motion for a Three Working Day Extension of Time to File StonCor's Reply Brief. That paper is number 40 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office electronic file for this proceeding.

At the time of filing of that motion, StonCor did not have the consent of Les Pierres' counsel to StonCor's motion.
