On November 16, 2009, the Board sent a notice of default to applicant in these consolidated proceedings because no amended answer had been filed in connection with opposer's corrected first amended notice of opposition.<sup>1</sup> The record shows no response thereto.

Accordingly, judgment by default is hereby entered against applicant, the opposition is sustained, and registration to applicant is refused. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 55, and Trademark Rule 2.106(a).

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<sup>1</sup> In the Board's order mailed September 10, 2009, applicant was allowed thirty days from the date of service of the second (i.e. corrected) amended notice of opposition to file an answer to the amended pleading. Opposer's amended pleading was filed on September 25, 2009.

In view of the foregoing, applicant (counterclaim-plaintiff) is allowed until **THIRTY DAYS** from the mailing date of this order to show cause why judgment should not be entered against it in regard to its counterclaim based on applicant's apparent loss of interest in this case.

This proceeding is otherwise **SUSPENDED**.
