Converse, Inc. argues that my logo for Stars Eagle League will create confusion among customers in a way that will harm them. I still maintain that my logo, although utilizing an altered star as an integral part of the overall design, is substantially different than theirs, and in no way will create confusion in the marketplace.

As to Converse Inc.'s claim that my logo would cause them harm, my logo is more dissimilar to theirs than the logos of such major entities as Texaco, Macy's, the Dallas Cowboys and the US Army (please see attached). Their use of unembellished stars (just like Converse) would cause more confusion and harm than my logo ever could. I am curious as to whether Converse Inc. takes issue with any of these companies' logos. It might be easier to bring action against a small individual entrepreneur than a corporate giant, but I believe the spirit and purpose of the trademark process will protect my right to fairly compete in the same marketplace that Converse Inc. does.


