**REQUEST TO AMEND APPLICATION WITH CONSENT
AND
STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE**

On December 14, 2011, the Board suspended Opposition No. 91184529 (the “Opposition”) pending disposition of a civil action between the same parties in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York (the “Civil Action”). The parties advise that they have reached a settlement of both the Opposition and Civil Action contingent on an amendment to the application underlying this proceeding, namely application Serial No. 77/364,616 (the “Application”).

To permit resolution of this matter, the parties jointly request that proceedings be resumed and, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.71(a), that the Application be amended to delete “facial tissues” and “bathroom tissues” from the current identification of goods. With this amendment, the identification of goods in the Application should read only: “**consumer and industrial paper products, namely, napkins and towels.**” This amendment does not require republication because the amendment to the identification of goods narrows rather than broadens its scope.

Upon approval of this amendment by the Board, and pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.106(c), the parties stipulate to the dismissal with prejudice of all claims and counterclaims in the Opposition.

Specifically, Opposer dismisses with prejudice all claims in the Opposition, and Applicant dismisses with prejudice all counterclaims in the Opposition.
