Opposer's consented motion (filed December 23, 2010) to suspend proceedings is **GRANTED**. Proceedings herein are **SUSPENDED until January 22, 2011**, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set forth in opposer's consented motion.

HOWEVER, the Board notes that the parties have sought numerous suspensions for settlement purposes since at least February 2, 2010, with a breakdown in settlement discussions in April 2010 and resumption thereof in October 2010 shortly

after the Board rendered its decision on opposer's motion for sanctions. Thus, in the event the parties seek any further extensions of time or suspension of proceedings, **the parties must provide a detailed report on the progress of their settlement negotiations to establish good cause for any continued suspension. Their report must include a recitation of issues that have been resolved, a recitation of issues that remain to be resolved, and firm timetable for resolution. Absent such a report, any future motion to extend or suspend may not be approved, even though agreed to by the parties.**

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.

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
