briefed motions for summary judgment and were suspended on

December 15, 2009 and scheduled to resume on March 14, 2010. Opposer had requested suspension to allow the parties time to discuss settlement. The Board granted the request in that had the parties been able to reach agreement, the summary judgment motions would have been rendered moot.

The Board has been in touch with the parties' counsel since March 14, 2010 and it is not clear whether they need additional time to continue their settlement discussions.

In that the Board does not want to expend unnecessary resources in deciding motions which may be rendered moot, we are extending the suspension period until April 2, 2010. If by April 2, 2010, the parties do not file a request for a further extension of the suspension period to allow for continued settlement negotiations, the motions for summary judgment will be taken up for consideration in all pending cases on April 5, 2010.

Proceedings otherwise remain suspended.
