

Always determined to use juggling to serve other people, I came up with the name "Juggling For A Cure," and created the logo that I am attempting to trademark.

Juggling For A Cure has been bringing enjoyment to seniors in nursing homes, patients in hospitals, and children in schools. One experience that I would like to share is a Juggling for Books program I held at Dr. Martin Luther King Park in Cincinnati, Ohio. Juggling for Books is a program of Juggling For A Cure. I juggle for children in the neighborhood, teach them how to juggle, and provide educational books for them to read. The books are on math, geography, U.S. History. Black History. Science, Art, and other subjects.

Dr. Martin Luther King Park is located in Avondale, the neighborhood I grew up in as a child. It is an inner city neighborhood struggling economically, and struggling with crime and drugs. I have seen negative things happening at the park – things that are not appropriate for children to be around. However, the children do not have much of a choice of places to play. Juggling For Books has been providing the children at the park with a positive option.

As I left the park, a young child (while leaving with his parents) loudly said, "Ken, will you be back tomorrow?" I answered, "Not sure if I'll make it back tomorrow, but I'll try to make it back." The child said, "Ken, I can't hear you, will you be back Ken?"

Juggling For A Cure is not an organization that goes into the community, but is already in the community. An organization bringing smiles of hope to the most precious in life.




