On September 27, 2010, applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 77856025, with opposer's written consent. On September 30, 2010, opposer filed a withdrawal of the opposition, without applicant's consent.

By the proposed amendment, applicant seeks to change the identification of services **from** "Conducting entertainment exhibitions in the nature of horror conventions; Entertainment services, namely, personal appearances by a celebrities; Entertainment services, namely, planning and conducting a series of film festivals; Entertainment, namely, live music concerts; Entertainment, namely, live performances by a musical band" **to** "Conducting entertainment exhibitions in the nature of horror conventions; Entertainment services, namely, personal appearances by a celebrities; Entertainment services, namely, planning and conducting a series of film festivals."

Opposition No. 91194934

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).
