On February 12, 2013, applicant's attorneys filed a request to withdraw as applicant's counsel of record in this case.¹ The request to withdraw as counsel is in compliance with the requirements of Trademark Rule 2.19(b) and Patent and Trademark Rule 10.40, and is accordingly granted. The law firm of Dan Thornburgh Law Corporation no longer represents applicant in this proceeding.

In view of the withdrawal of applicant's counsel, and in accordance with standard Board practice, proceedings herein are suspended, and applicant is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to either appoint new counsel, or to file a paper stating that applicant chooses to represent itself. If applicant files no response, the Board may issue an

order to show cause why default judgment should not be entered against applicant based on applicant's apparent loss of interest in the case.

In the event applicant either appoints new counsel or indicates that it will represent itself, applicant must indicate in the same filing whether the pending motion to compel has been resolved between the parties, failing which the motion will be denied without prejudice.

The parties will be notified by the Board when proceedings are resumed, and dates will be rescheduled at the appropriate time.
