On July 13, 2011, applicant filed a stipulated motion to suspend proceedings and to amend its involved application Serial No. 85107108, with opposer's written consent. By the proposed amendment, applicant seeks to change the identification of goods in International Class 21 as follows:
from: "Dental flossing tools and flossing accessories, namely, floss sticks, floss filament, floss cartridges, floss holders, floss dispensers, floss tool holders, floss tools in the shape of nunchucks, and flossing systems comprised of floss sticks, floss filament, floss cartridges, floss holders, and floss dispensers"

to "floss tools in the shape of nunchucks."

The goods in International Class 28 would remain unchanged.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer

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consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **THIRTY DAYS** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c). Proceedings herein are otherwise suspended.
