NOTICE OF MOTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to TBMP § 507.01 and Fed. R. Civ. P. §15(a), Opposer hereby moves for entry of an order granting Opposer leave to file a Second Amended Notice of Opposition to correct a typographical error. This motion (“Opposer’s Motion”) is based upon the Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the attached Declaration of Tali L. Alban (“Alban Decl.”), the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board’s file herein, and such further evidence and arguments as the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (the “Board”) may consider. Opposer also attaches to the proposed Second Amended Notice of Opposition the registrations upon which it relies, in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.122(d).

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. INTRODUCTION

Opposer made one minor clerical error in a Notice of Opposition that it hereby wishes to correct through an Amended Pleading. This mistake has had no impact on the proceedings to date, and Applicant will not be prejudiced in any way if this amendment is allowed. Given the liberal standard applied to motions for leave, so that the justice will be served and cases decided on their merits, leave should be granted here so that one mistaken reference to HUNTER GIRL is changed to GIRL HUNTER in the Amended Notice of Opposition. Applicant's counsel itself has made similar --and repeated -- minor mistakes, and cannot fairly complain about this minor correction.

II. FACTS

On April 20, 2011, Opposer filed a Notice of Opposition, opposing registration in class 25 of the mark GIRL HUNTER (stylized), as shown Application Serial No. 76/702,199. The caption of the pleading clearly identified the disputed mark as "GIRL HUNTER", as did the introductory paragraph. The serial number was correctly referenced throughout. In paragraph 4 of the Notice of Opposition, however, Opposer mistakenly defined the mark shown in Application Ser. No. 76/702,199 as "HUNTER GIRL". Clearly, this was a typographical error. (Alban Decl. ¶ 2.) Applicant, acting *pro se*, filed its Answer on May 16, 2011. Although Applicant noted the typographical error in Paragraph 4 of its Answer, Opposer did not notice. Subsequently, the parties held their mandatory discovery conference (on June 27, 2011). The Interlocutory Attorney presided over the conference, at the request of Applicant. The typographical error was not discussed or raised as an issue. (Alban Decl. ¶ 3.)

Shortly after the discovery conference, on June 28, 2011, and in response to a request from the Interlocutory Attorney, Opposer filed an Amended Notice of Opposition, to remove reference to dilution (15 U.S.C. § 1125(c)), which Opposer had intended to delete before filing, but inadvertently did not. (Alban Decl. ¶ 4.) Opposer was focused on the errant dilution claim and failed to correct the typographical error that time. Applicant retained counsel, who then filed an Appearance of Counsel in this matter—identifying the wrong mark in the caption. The new counsel answered the Notice of Opposition with a completely revised Answer, and added counterclaims, on August 4, 2011. Applicant thereafter realized it had made a clerical mistake in listing the wrong parties in the caption, and filed an “Amended Answer” to correct its own mistake.

Although the Applicant raised the issue of the typographical error in its Answer and Counterclaim, the parties have proceeded with this litigation, clearly acting under the correct understanding that the disputed mark is GIRL HUNTER. The captions of each party’s filings and discovery documents reflect the appropriate mark, the parties have responded to discovery based on the correct mark, and in the multiple correspondences and telephone conversations held, including a telephonic hearing with the Interlocutory Attorney concerning discovery issues, the clerical error has never been raised. (Alban Decl. ¶ 5.) It is clear that the parties have both understood, and proceeded under the understanding, that the disputed mark is indeed GIRL HUNTER, as shown in Application Ser. No. 76/702,199.

On or around June 4, 2012, while reviewing its Amended Notice of Opposition, Opposer realized that, although it had intended to correct the clerical error in its Amended Notice of Opposition, it had not yet done so. (Alban Decl. ¶ 6.) Although the parties clearly understood that this error was clerical, and that the disputed mark is, and always has been, GIRL HUNTER,

Opposer wished to clarify the record for trial. Opposer thus asked the Interlocutory Attorney how best to go about correcting the record, and the Interlocutory Attorney advised Opposer that it should file a Motion for Leave. (Alban Decl. ¶ 6.) As Opposer was in the process of preparing approximately 2,000 pages of documents for production - due on Friday June 8, 2012 - in response to Applicant's requests for production, it waited until Monday, June 11, 2012, to turn its attention to the instant Motion.¹

Accordingly, Opposer now respectfully moves for leave to file a Second Amended Notice of Opposition. The only proposed correction is to correct one clerical error in paragraph 4, wherein Applicant's mark should have been described as GIRL HUNTER as opposed to "Hunter Girl," and to attach, as an exhibit, the full TARR records for its trademark registrations, pursuant to Rule 2.122(d).

III. LEAVE TO AMEND IS WARRANTED

Under the Federal Rules, leave to amend pleadings should be "freely given when justice so requires." Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a); 37 CFR §2.107. See also *See Foman v. Davis*, 371 U.S. 178, 182 (reaffirming Rule 15(a)'s policy of freely granting leave to amend). This is particularly so when the error the moving party wishes to correct is purely clerical in nature. *See, e.g., Kinsey v. E & G Pizza Corp.*, 2000 WL 1911885, at *3 (S.D. Ind. Dec. 8, 2000) (noting that since the plaintiff's citation to the wrong statute in its Complaint was a typographical error, justice required allowing plaintiff the opportunity to amend that section of the complaint.)

¹ Clutching at straws, Applicant has, in the interim, apparently seized this opportunity to attempt to divert attention from the merits of the case and has filed a Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings, based on this clerical error. As discussed further herein, Applicant can hardly claim prejudice based on this error, as it has shown time and time again that it is aware that the mark at issue is GIRL HUNTER, as indicated by the subject Application Serial Number in the caption of each and every document filed and served in this case.

Similarly, Section 507.02 of the TBMP expressly states, in relevant part:

[t]he Board liberally grants leave to amend pleading at any stage of a proceeding when justice so requires, unless entry of the proposed amendment would violate settled law or be prejudicial to the rights of the adverse party of parties.

(internal citations omitted). *See, e.g., Van Dyne-Crotty Inv. V. Wear-Guard Corp.*, 926 F.2d 1156 (Fed. Cir. 1991) (amendment to add later-acquired registration to tack on prior owner's use); *Space Base Inc. v. Stadis Corp.*, 17 U.S.P.Q.2d 1216 (TTAB 1990) (notice of opposition amended during testimony period to add newly issued registration). As the Board has previously recognized in explaining the liberal policy favoring amendments: "pleadings are not an end in themselves, but are a means to proper presentation of case." *Microsoft Corp. v. Qantel Business Systems, Inc.*, 16 U.S.P.Q. 1732, 1733 (TTAB 1990). If adding substantive matter to a Notice of Opposition, such as the addition of a registration, is not prejudicial to an Applicant, certainly correcting a clerical error, and attaching the full registration records (which Applicant, in its Answer, has admitted are owned by Opposer) cannot be.

As indicated above, the Opposer here wishes only to correct paragraph 4 of the Amended Notice of Opposition, so that it comports with the caption and properly identifies Applicant's mark as GIRL HUNTER, and not "Hunter Girl", and to attach the registration records. As such an edit and exhibit changes nothing with respect to the actual merits – since there has been no dispute over ownership or current status of the registrations - of the matter, justice requires that Opposer be entitled to correct its error.

As the opposition is still in discovery stage, no undue prejudice will result from allowing the proposed amendment to the Notice of Opposition. *See Hurley International v. Volta*, 82 U.S.P.Q.2d 1339, 1341 (TTAB 2007). The proposed amendment is modest and simply needed

to identify the proper mark for a clean record. Applicant has been well aware of the legal basis of Opposer's opposition, i.e., likelihood of confusion with Opposer's HUNTER marks, since Opposer first filed the Notice of Opposition. Applicant simply cannot reasonably claim to have suffered prejudice due to this clerical error. The entire course of conduct between the parties makes clear that Applicant has known all along that the mark at issue is GIRL HUNTER. Such course of conduct includes:

- both parties' service of and response to discovery requests – all relating to the application for the mark GIRL HUNTER;
- multiple emails and telephone conferences over the course of the proceeding, none of which referenced the erroneously typed "Hunter Girl";
- participation in a discovery conference and telephonic hearing with the Interlocutory Attorney relating to Opposer's Motion to Compel discovery, during which the issue of paragraph 4 of the Notice of Opposition never arose;
- the fact that in each document served and filed, including the original and Amended Notices of Opposition, the correct mark has appeared in the caption;
- Applicant never sought to clarify with Opposer, formally or through discovery, whether Opposer had intended to identify a different mark.

(Alban Decl. ¶ 5.)

The mere correction of a typographical error (notwithstanding Applicant's unwise decision to file a counterclaim and a Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings based, not on the merits but on a typographical error), will have no discernible impact on the proceedings herein nor unfairly prejudice Applicant in any way. Likewise, permitting Opposer to attach the full

registration records cannot prejudice Applicant, who has never disputed ownership, current status or authenticity of Opposer's registrations.

IV. CONCLUSION


Opposer respectfully requests that the Board grant Opposer's motion for leave to file a Second Amended Notice of Opposition in the interests of justice.

I, Tali L. Alban, declare:

1. I am an attorney at the law firm Kilpatrick, Townsend & Stockton LLP, duly licensed to practice in the State of California and before this Board, and one of the attorneys for Opposer Hunter Boot Limited ("Opposer") in this Opposition proceeding. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein and, if called, could and would testify competently to those facts. I submit this Declaration in Support of Opposer's Motion for Leave to Amend Notice of Opposition.

2. On April 20, 2011, I drafted and had filed a Notice of Opposition, opposing registration in class 25 of the mark GIRL HUNTER (stylized), as shown in Application Serial No. 76/702,199 and filed by Georgia Pellegrini Media Group, LLC. While the Caption of the Notice was correct, in one instance (paragraph 4), I inadvertently switched the order of Applicant's mark, so that the mark read "HUNTER GIRL", rather than the correct "GIRL HUNTER." This was a typographical error.

3. On June 27, 2011, I participated in a discovery conference with Applicant, who appeared *pro se*, and Mr. Kim, the Interlocutory Attorney. To the best of my recollection, the typographical error was not discussed or raised as an issue at that time.

4. On June 28, 2011, in response to a request from the Interlocutory Attorney, members of my firm filed an Amended Notice of Opposition, to remove reference to dilution (15 U.S.C. § 1125(c)), which was supposed to have been deleted prior to filing, but was not. As we were focused on the errant dilution claim, we failed to notice and correct the typographical error at the same time.

5. During the course of the litigation, Opposer has both served discovery requests and responded to Applicant's discovery requests, all evidencing the correct mark, GIRL HUNTER. The parties have also exchanged multiple correspondences and participated in several telephone conversations, and at no time, to the best of my knowledge, did Applicant, or its counsel, raise the typographical issue or show any uncertainty as to what mark was at issue in this proceeding.

6. On June 4, 2012, the parties participated in a telephonic hearing with the Interlocutory Attorney concerning Opposer's Motion to Compel. During that hearing, the Interlocutory Attorney asked Opposer to confirm that it was not asserting a claim for dilution.

After the hearing, I reviewed Opposer's Amended Notice of Opposition and confirmed that Opposer had withdrawn any reference to dilution. I also then noticed that the one clerical error in paragraph 4 of the Amended Notice had not been corrected. Accordingly, I asked the Interlocutory Attorney how best to correct the error, and he recommended that Opposer file a Motion for Leave.





HUNTER BOOT LIMITED, a United Kingdom Limited Liability Company, located at 36 Melville Street, Edinburgh, Scotland EH3 7HA, and doing business in the United States, believes that it will be damaged by the registration in International Class 25 of the mark GIRL HUNTER (stylized), as shown in Application Serial No. 76/702,199 filed by Georgia Pellegrini Media Group, LLC. ("Applicant"), a New York Limited Liability Company, with a mailing

address at 99 Rockland Road, Sparkill, New York 10976, and published in the Official Gazette of December 21, 2010, and hereby opposes registration thereof.

As grounds for opposition, Hunter Boot Limited alleges:

1. Hunter Boot Limited (“Opposer”) is the owner of the following U.S. registrations:
 - a. No. 1,550,244, for the mark ROYAL HUNTER in class 25 for “weatherproof boots”. Opposer’s application for this registration was filed on May 12, 1988, based on use in commerce since at least as early as March, 1986, and matured to registration on August 1, 1989;
 - b. No. 2,740,877 for the mark HUNTER for “footwear” in class 25. Opposer’s application for registration No. 2,740,877 was filed on July 30, 1997, based on use in commerce since at least as early as November 28, 1983, and matured to registration on July 29, 2003; and
 - c. No. 3,876,340 also for the mark HUNTER & Design, which covers a variety of goods and services in classes 3, 9, 14, 18, 20, 21, 24, and 25. The goods identified in class 25 include: “Clothing, namely, skirts, culottes, pants, blouses; footwear; headgear, namely, hats and caps; boots; welts for boots and shoes; non-slipping devices for boots, namely, studs for boots, studs for shoes, over soles for boots and shoes; inner soles; heels and soles for footwear; insoles for boots and shoes; liners for boots and shoes; shaped bags and pouches adapted to carry boots and shoes, namely, bags for Wellington boots, bags for waterproof boots, bags for hiking boots and bags for hiking shoes; socks; hats; gloves; scarves; waterproof footwear; galoshes; garters; headbands; jackets; jerseys; jumpers; knitwear, namely, knitted gloves,

jerseys, jumpers, sweaters, cardigans, pullovers, waistcoats and tank-tops; neck ties; outer clothing, namely, outer jackets, outer coats, raincoats, trenchcoats and outdoor gloves; aprons; overalls; overcoats; pajamas; pants; sandals; flip-flops; shirts; shoes; slippers; sun visors and caps; sweaters; swimsuits; T-shirts; top hats; top coats; trousers; undergarments; underpants and underwear; fishing vests; waistcoats; and waterproof clothing, namely, waterproof jackets, waterproof coats, waterproof raincoats and waterproof pants; sports clothing, namely, sports singlets, sports T-shirts, sports sweatshirts, sports sweat pants, sports tracksuits, sports jerseys; sports footwear, namely, rubber shoes, training shoes and athletic shoes; after-sports footwear; belts and money belts". Opposer's application for registration No. 3,876,340 was filed on January 23, 2009 and claimed a priority date of July 24, 2008. Said application matured to registration on November 16, 2010.

Copies of Opposer's Certificates of Registration (hereinafter, individually and collectively, "Opposer's Marks") for the aforementioned registrations are attached as Exhibit A.

2. Opposer has used Opposer's Marks extensively, exclusively, and continuously throughout the United States and elsewhere since at least as early as 1983. Opposer has extensively advertised its HUNTER-brand product lines in the United States, and elsewhere. Opposer's goods, including but not limited to boots, footwear and clothing, have been very well received by the consuming public and have been the subject of substantial positive publicity over the years.

3. By virtue of Opposer's extensive use and promotion of Opposer's Marks, and substantial sales of products bearing Opposer's Marks, Opposer has established valuable goodwill in the marks, and the public has come to associate these marks with Opposer. As such, the public has come to know the mark HUNTER in connection with footwear and apparel, as an indication of goods that originate from Opposer.

4. On March 23, 2010, Applicant filed U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 76/702,199 for the mark GIRL HUNTER (stylized) ("Applicant's Mark") in connection with "clothing, namely, t-shirts, sweat shirts, jackets, shirts, pants, shoes, shorts and gloves; hunting apparel, namely, pants, shirts, jackets, hats, gloves and shoes" in class 25, under section 1(b) of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1051(b).

5. On information and belief, Applicant had not yet commenced use in commerce of Applicant's Mark at the time it filed its application.

6. The dominant part of Applicant's Mark, the word "HUNTER", incorporates Opposer's Marks in whole or in substantial part.

7. The use of the word "GIRL" in Applicant's Mark is descriptive and is likely to be viewed by the consuming public as a sub-brand of Opposer's well-known HUNTER-brand.

8. As a result of the above, Applicant's Mark is highly similar in overall commercial impression to Opposer's Marks.

9. Further, Applicant's goods as described in the Application are in the same class, and are closely related to, if not overlapping with, the goods and services identified in Opposer's Registration Nos. 1,550,244, 2,740,877, and 3,876,340, and with the goods with which Opposer has been using Opposer's Marks for many years prior to the time Applicant filed Application Ser. No. 76/702,199.

10. As a result of the similarity between Opposer's Marks and Applicant's Mark, and the highly related nature of the parties' respective goods and services, Applicant's Mark is likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception in the trade and among purchasers as to the source, origin or sponsorship of the parties' respective goods and services.

11. Pursuant to the allegations stated above, registration of Applicant's Mark shown in the opposed Application will result in damage to Opposer under the provisions of § 2(d) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

12. If the Application is permitted to register, the registration would presumptively entitle Applicant to *prima facie* exclusive ownership and rights to Applicant's Mark. Such registration would cause confusion among consumers as to the separate and distinct sources of Applicant's goods and Opposer's goods and the relationship of Opposer to Applicant, thereby damaging Opposer's goodwill in its marks, and resulting in irreparable harm to Opposer's business and reputation, all to the detriment of Opposer, who has expended considerable sums and effort in promoting its marks.

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that this Opposition be sustained and that registration of U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 76/702,199 be denied.


