Opposer's motion (filed June 16, 2011) to suspend Board proceedings pending final determination of a civil action between the parties is granted as conceded and well-taken. See Trademark Rules 2.117(a) and 2.127(a). Accordingly, proceedings are suspended pending final disposition of the civil action between the parties.¹

Within twenty days after the final determination of the civil action (i.e., within twenty days after the expiration of time in which to file an appeal), the parties

shall so notify the Board so that this case may be called up for appropriate action (including, if appropriate, resetting the deadline for the discovery conference). During the suspension period, the parties shall notify the Board of any address changes for the parties or their attorneys.²
