On December 11, 2015, Opposers, in response to the Board's November 12, 2015 order to show cause, filed a motion to "extend" time to file their brief on the case, concurrently with their brief on the case. Because Opposers' time to file a brief had expired when they filed their motion, that motion is actually one to reopen such time. *See* Fed. R. Civ. 6(b)(1)(B); TBMP § 509.01(b).

On December 17, 2015, Applicant's attorney stated by telephone that Applicant would not oppose that motion. Accordingly, the order to show cause that the Board issued under Trademark Rule 2.128(a)(3) is set aside, and the motion to reopen time to file a brief on the case is granted. Opposers' brief on the case is accepted and made of record.

Applicant is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date set forth in this order to file a brief on the case. Opposers' reply brief on the case is due in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a)(1).
