Appearance

On May 2, 2012, Kevin C. Parks filed a notice of appearance on behalf of opposer and requested that correspondence be sent to him. On May 10, 2012, Mary A. Donovan filed a request to withdraw as opposer's counsel of record. In view thereof, Kevin C. Parks is recognized as opposer's counsel in this proceeding, and Mary A. Donovan's motion to withdraw is granted. Board records have been accordingly updated. TBMP § 117.02 (3d ed. rev. 2012).

Telephone Conference

The parties are ordered to find mutually convenient times and dates that are prior to July 28, 2012, in which to participate in a telephone conference with the Board to determine opposer's outstanding motion for an extension of time (filed May 17, 2012) and applicant's cross-motion for an extension of time (filed June 4, 2012). Once the parties have

found mutually convenient times, the parties must telephone the Board (at 571-272-9467) with their proposed dates to coordinate scheduling the conference with the Interlocutory Attorney.

Representation

As noted above, Kevin C. Parks is recognized as opposer's counsel in this proceeding. Any individual who is an attorney as defined in Patent and Trademark Rule 11.1, 37 C.F.R. §11.1, may represent others before the Office in trademark matters.

Office records indicate that subject application Serial No. 85007380 is owned by Yael Mamroud/ Cummins, a Canadian corporation, and that Yael Mamroud is Vice President thereof.¹ Inasmuch as a corporation may represent itself in a Board proceeding by way of a corporate officer who is authorized to represent the corporation, Ms. Mamroud is recognized as applicant's representative. Patent and Trademark Rule 11.14(e), 37 C.F.R. §11.14(e).

¹Although Ms. Mamroud signed applicant's June 4th cross-motion "on behalf of 9226-8754 Quebec Inc. DBA Vitamine & Sea," and identified applicant in the caption of the motion as "Yael Mamroud / Cummins (on behalf of Vitamine & Sea)," it is Yael Mamroud/ Cummins, a Canadian corporation, which is the owner of record of the subject application.
