ELIZABETH J. WINTER, INTERLOCUTORY ATTORNEY:

On May 15, 2012, applicant filed a request to amend the involved applications, Serial Nos. 85207828 and 85211907, with opposer's consent, and also requested that the proceeding be suspended pending the Board's consideration of the proposed amendments.

By the proposed amendments, applicant seeks to change the identifications of goods and services as follows,

From:

International Class 01: Antibodies for scientific or research use;

International Class 40: Antibody services, namely, custom antibody production and generation; custom manufacture of antibodies for others; and

International Class 42: Scientific research and development, namely, development of antibodies for others.

To:¹

Antibodies for scientific or research use, **excluding such uses having application to agriculture** (International Class 1);

Antibody services, namely, custom antibody production and generation; custom manufacture of antibodies for others, **excluding such antibody services having application to agriculture** (International Class 40); and

Scientific research and development, namely, development of antibodies for others, **excluding scientific research and development services having application to agriculture** (International Class 42).

Inasmuch as the proposed amendments are clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, they are approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this order resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **THIRTY DAYS** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the applications as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).

This proceeding is otherwise **SUSPENDED**.
