Motion to Suspend

The parties' stipulation (filed April 24, 2012) to suspend this proceeding for ninety days pending determination of two civil actions, namely, *Rare Breed*,

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Inc. v Rare Breed M.C., Inc. Case No. BC478602, filed in Los Angeles (California) Superior Court, and *Rare Breed M.C. Inc. v. Rarebreed Motorcycle Club, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 30-2012 00544948, filed in Orange County Superior Court, is granted to the extent modified herein. See Trademark Rule 2.117(a).

Proceedings are suspended pending final disposition (including any appeals or remands) of the two civil actions.

Within twenty days after the final determination of the later-determined civil action, the parties shall so notify the Board so that this case may be called up for appropriate action.

During the suspension period, the parties shall notify the Board of any address changes for the parties or their attorneys.
