By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

On March 25, 2014, applicant filed a proposed amendment to application Serial No. 85451415, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal with prejudice of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to amend the description of services from

"financial services, namely, electronic credit card transaction services, namely, initiating and supporting charitable contribution donation programs that allow the use of credit card for donations to the cause of others"

to

"financial services, namely, electronic credit card transaction services, namely, initiating and supporting charitable contribution donation programs that allow the use of credit card for donations to the cause of others, all of the foregoing excluding offering of services to charities whose primary services or function is the renovation, repair, or construction of homes or residential buildings."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer

consents thereto, the amendment is approved and entered.

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice.
