The stipulated protective agreement filed on June 10, 2013 is noted and its use in this proceeding is approved. The parties are referred, as appropriate, See TBMP §§ 412 (Protective Order), 412.04 (Filing Confidential Materials With Board), 412.05 (Handling of Confidential Materials by the Board).

The parties are advised that only confidential or trade secret information should be filed pursuant to a stipulated protective agreement. Such an agreement may not be used as a means of circumventing Trademark Rules 2.27(d) and (e), which provide, in essence, that the file of a published application or issued registration, and all

proceedings relating thereto, should otherwise be available for public inspection.

Opposer's motion for a protective order filed May 13, 2013 is noted. Along with their stipulated protective order the parties agreed to withdraw opposer's motion for a protective order. Accordingly, opposer's motion for a protective order filed May 13, 2013 is moot and will receive no further consideration.
