On February 4, 2014, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 85369525, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal with prejudice of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods in Class 9 **from** "Content management software for managing professional newspapers and magazines, namely, for managing breaking news, full length articles, blogs, comments and editorial staff through intuitive interfaces and intelligent workflows; data-processing equipment; computers; apparatus and instruments for recording, reproduction and transmission of information, including text, image and sound by internet and intranet electronic channels" **to** "Content management software for managing professional newspapers and magazines, namely, for managing breaking news,

full length articles, blogs, comments and editorial staff through intuitive interfaces and intelligent workflows; data-processing equipment; computers; apparatus and instruments for recording, reproduction and transmission of information, including text, image and sound by internet and intranet electronic channels; all the foregoing for use with content management software and none of the foregoing for use in connection with creating, selling and syndicating content alone or in teams."¹

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of services in Class 38 **from** "Communications by telephone; communications by telegrams; communications by computer terminals; communication by fiber-optic networks; providing internet chat rooms; paging services by radio, telephone and other means of electronic communication" **to** "Communications by telephone; communications by telegrams; communications by computer terminals; communication by fiber-optic networks; providing internet chat rooms; paging services by radio, telephone and other means of electronic communication; all the foregoing for use with content management software and none of the foregoing for use in connection with creating, selling and syndicating content alone or in teams."

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of services in Class 42 **from** "Computer programming; designing and developing of computer software; consultancy in computer software; ~~providing search engines for the internet~~" **to**

"Computer programming; designing and developing of computer software; consultancy in computer software; all the foregoing for use with content management software and none of the foregoing for use in connection with creating, selling and syndicating content alone or in teams."²

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice.
