On August 6, 2013, applicant filed an abandonment of its application Serial No. 85463689 with an allegation of opposer's consent under Trademark Rule 2.68.

However, the applicable rule is Trademark Rule 2.135, which provides that if, in an inter partes proceeding, the applicant files an abandonment without the written consent of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against the applicant.

Accordingly, because opposer's written consent to the abandonment is not of record, applicant is hereby allowed until THIRTY DAYS to submit opposers written consent, failing which judgment will be entered against applicant. At such, time the opposition will be sustained and registration to applicant refused.
