On September 13, 2013, applicant filed an abandonment of its application Serial No. 85293399 with prejudice.

Trademark Rule 2.135, provides that if, in an inter partes proceeding, the applicant files an abandonment without the written consent of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against the applicant.

Applicant claims that it has the consent of opposer, but failed to provide opposer's written consent to the Board. Accordingly, applicant is allowed until *thirty days* from the mailing date of this order to provide opposer's written consent to the abandonment, failing which judgment shall be entered against applicant and the opposition sustained.
