OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO ANSWER

Opposer hereby opposes Applicant's motion for an extension of time to answer the captioned opposition.

The Opposition was filed on February 13, 2013. Applicant has been aware of the opposition since service was completed.
