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NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Marvel Characters, Inc. (“Opposer”), a corporation of the State of Delaware, having a principal place of business at 1600 Rosecrans Avenue, Manhattan Beach, California, 90266, believes that it is being and will be damaged by the registration of the mark shown in Application Serial No. 85483515, and hereby opposes the same. As grounds for its opposition, Opposer alleges that, upon actual knowledge with respect to itself and its own acts, and upon information and belief as to other matters:

Opposer and its Business

1. Opposer, by and through its predecessors and related companies (collectively “Opposer”), is one of the world’s most prominent character-based entertainment companies, with a library of over 8,000 characters featured in a variety of media for over seventy years.

2. Since at least December 1990, Opposer has used its SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark in commerce in connection with publications, namely comic books, magazines and stories, and trading cards. SABRETOOTH is the name of one of Opposer’s prominent fictional villains in the *X-Men*. The SABRETOOTH character appears in the first Wolverine movie titled, *X-Men Origins: Wolverine*, released in the

Spring of 2009.

3. Opposer's SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark has also been prominently featured in several *X-Men* animated television series and video games. Additionally, Opposer's SABRETOOTH character has been ranked among the best comic-book characters of all time.

4. Opposer has a long history of using its characters, names, and marks appearing in one medium (e.g., comic book) and creating a franchise of creative works around the character (e.g., novels, motion pictures, television shows, computer games, etc.).

5. Further, Opposer has a long history of merchandising its characters, names, and marks (themselves and through licensees) on a wide variety of merchandise ranging from key chains and pins to stickers and notebooks to all types of bags to house wares to bedding and linens to apparel and to sporting goods, just to name a few.

6. Opposer has used its SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark in commerce in connection with, among other products, comic books, trading cards, posters, magnets, action figures, clothing, video games, arcade games, and films since before the filing date of Application Serial No. 85483515, and any date of first use that may be alleged by Applicant.

7. Opposer's SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark have received unsolicited media attention nationwide, including but not limited to coverage in nationally circulated publications such as The New York Times, The New York Post, The Dallas Morning Star, The Seattle Times, The Washington Times, The Boston Herald, The Miami Herald, The Milwaukee Sentinel, The Associated Press, and Dow Jones Online, just to name a few. Such media attention has had a substantial impact on the public, and evidences the fame of Opposer's SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark.

8. In addition, Opposer also owns valid and subsisting U.S. Registration No. 1836773 for the SABRETOOTH mark for “publications; namely, comic books and magazines and stories in illustrated form; trading cards” in Class 16. (Printouts from the U.S. Patent and Trademark TDSR database, including assignment records, are attached as Exhibit A) (collectively, the goods and services in Paragraphs 2-7 above are referred to as “Opposer’s Goods and Services”).

9. The foregoing registration is valid and subsisting and constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity of the mark and registration, and of Opposer’s ownership of and exclusive right to use the SABRETOOTH mark in commerce.

Applicant and its Application

10. Sabertooth Motorcycles, LLC. (“Applicant”), the listed owner of Application Serial No. 85483515, is a limited liability company of Delaware with an address of 26 Lyman Road, Chestnut Hill, Massachusetts, 02467.

11. On November 30, 2011, Applicant filed Application Serial No. 85483515 to register the SABERTOOTH mark (“the SABERTOOTH Application”) under Section 1(a), 15 U.S.C. §1051(a), before the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (“PTO”) for the following goods:

Articles of protective clothing for protection against accident or injury for use in motorcycling and motorsports.; Audio equipment for vehicles, namely, stereos, speakers, amplifiers, equalizers, crossovers and speaker housings; Audio tapes featuring music; Automatic indicators of low pressure in tires; Automotive measuring instruments, namely, water temperature gauges, air fuel/ratio gauges, boost gauges, vacuum gauges and exhaust gas temperature gauges; Automotive testing equipment, namely, transmission testing and brake testing equipment; Backlit signs; Bags and cases specially adapted for holding or carrying portable telephones and telephone equipment and accessories; Bags for cameras and photographic equipment; Batteries and battery chargers; Battery boxes; Battery monitors; Bicycle helmets; Body armor; Camera cases; Car broadcasting tuners; Car navigation computers; Carrying cases for electronic equipment, namely, cellphones, computers; Cases for eyeglasses and sunglasses; Cases for music, audio and related electronic equipment, namely, cases for audio tuners, audio receivers, amplifiers, tape players, compact disc players, MP3 controllers/players,

audio mixers, audio speakers in the nature of music studio monitors, microphones, audio speakers, compact discs, audio tapes, portable computers, antennas, phonographic record players, audio recording equipment, and the cables associated with all of the foregoing equipment; Cellular telephones; Chargers for batteries; Clothing for protection against accidents, irradiation and fire; Computer application software for mobile phones, namely, software for smartphones that provides users the ability to remotely control features of their motor vehicle.; Computer game software; Computer software and hardware for remotely monitoring motor vehicle location and systems.; Computer software for operating a motor vehicle dealership.; Crash helmets; Cruise controls for motor vehicles; Cruise controls for motorcycles; Downloadable electronic newsletters in the field of motorcycles, motor vehicles and motorsports.; DVDs featuring motorcycles and motorsports.; Electric signs; Electronic controllers for motor vehicle steering, traction and stability control.; Electronic game software; Electronic publications, namely, magazines and manuals featuring motorcycles, motor vehicles and motorsports recorded on computer media; Electronic signs; Eyewear; Eyewear cases; Fridge magnets; Gloves for protection against accidents; GPS navigation device; Helmets for bicycles; Helmets for motorcyclists; Holders for compact discs; Jump start cables; Keyless entry system and keyless ignition switch system for automotive vehicles comprised of a microprocessor, electronic signal receiver, and keyfob with electronic signal transponder; Knee pads for workers; Laptop carrying cases; Life jackets; Mechanical signs; Motor vehicle to trailer electrical connectors; Motorcycle goggles; Motorcycle helmets; Mouse pads; Mousepads; Musical recordings; Neon signs; Parts for anti-theft automotive alarms, namely, electronic sensors, remote control transmitters and receivers for remotely operating land vehicles; Pre-paid telephone calling cards, magnetically encoded; Protective helmets; Protective industrial boots; Protective padded clothing for protection against bodily harm and blunt force trauma; Protective work gloves; Racing safety apparel, namely, flame retardant balaclavas; Radar detectors; Radios for vehicles; Refrigerator magnets; Safety goggles; Safety helmets; Safety products, namely, embroidered reflective patches to be worn on clothing; Safety products, namely, reflective helmet skirts; Safety products, namely, reflective safety bands to be worn on the body; Sirens; Slide boxes; Snow goggles; Speedometers; Sunglasses; Support belts for workers; Tachometers; Tire pressure gauges; Tire tread depth gauges; Vehicle locating, tracking and security system comprised of an antenna and radio transmitter to be placed in a vehicle; Vehicle locator and recovery device programmed to use global positioning systems (GPS) and cellular telecommunications; Vehicle radios; Vehicle safety equipment, namely, back-up sensors and cameras; Vehicle safety equipment, namely, electronic tire pressure monitors; Vehicle safety equipment, namely, electronic vibration, shock, motion, angle, temperature and voltage monitors; Vehicle tracking devices comprised of cellular radio modules, computer software and computer hardware, sensors, transmitters, receivers and global positioning satellite receivers, all for use in connection with vehicle tracking, vehicle monitoring and anti-theft vehicle alarms; Vehicles breakdown warning lamps; Voltmeters; Warning triangles to indicate vehicle breakdowns; Welding helmets in Class 9.

12. Applicant filed the SABERTOOTH Application under Section 1(a), 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a), claiming that “the mark was first used by the applicant or the applicant's related company or licensee predecessor in interest at least as early as 02/01/2002, and first used in commerce at least as early as 03/01/2002, and is now in use in such commerce.”

13. On November 30, 2011, Ben Daniels (“Daniels”), President of Sabertooth Motorcycles, LLC, signed the verified declaration on behalf of Applicant under 18 U.S.C. Section 1001 in support of the SABERTOOTH Application. Applicant, through Daniels, declared under penalty of fine or imprisonment “that willful false statements, and the like, may jeopardize the validity of the application or any resulting registration....”

14. On February 7, 2012, the PTO issued an Office Action (“PTO’s First Office Action”) requesting a substitute specimen of use, among other things. The PTO’s First Office Action stated that “[t]he specimen is not acceptable because it consists of advertising material for goods.” The PTO also required a verified declaration in support of the substitute specimen.

15. On August 5, 2012, in response to the PTO’s First Office Action, Applicant repeated the long list of goods stated in the original application (“Applicant’s First Response”). Applicant also declared that it “is using the mark in commerce, or the applicant’s related company or licensee is using the mark in commerce, on or in connection with the identified goods and/or services. 15 U.S.C. Section 1051(a), as amended. The mark was first used at least as early as 02/01/2002 and first used in commerce at least as early as 03/01/2002, and is now in use in such commerce.”

16. In addition, Applicant’s First Response declared, among other things, “the applicant is seeking registration under Section 1(a) of the Trademark Act, the mark was in use in commerce on or in connection with the goods and/or services listed in the application as of the application filing date or as of the date of any submitted allegation of

use... The undersigned, being hereby warned that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. Section 1001, and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the application or any resulting registration....”

17. On September 10, 2012, the PTO issued a Final Office Action (“PTO’s Final Office Action”) reiterating the requirements and refusals made in the PTO’s First Office Action.

18. On November 9, 2012, Applicant filed a Request for Reconsideration (“Applicant’s Request for Reconsideration”) of the PTO’s Final Office Action. Applicant again repeated the same identification of goods from the original application, and which appears to be identical to the goods listed in Applicant’s First Response.

19. Applicant’s Request for Reconsideration also declared that it “is using the mark in commerce, or the applicant’s related company or licensee is using the mark in commerce, on or in connection with the identified goods and/or services. 15 U.S.C. Section 1051(a), as amended. The mark was first used at least as early as 02/01/2002 and first used in commerce at least as early as 03/01/2002, and is now in use in such commerce.”

20. In addition, Applicant’s Request for Reconsideration contained a declaration stating, among other things, “the applicant is seeking registration under Section 1(a) of the Trademark Act, the mark was in use in commerce on or in connection with the goods and/or services listed in the application as of the application filing date or as of the date of any submitted allegation of use... The undersigned, being hereby warned that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. Section 1001, and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the application or any resulting registration....”

21. On November 20, 2012, the PTO approved the SABERTOOTH Application for publication.

22. On December 25, 2012, the SABERTOOTH Application was published for opposition in the *Trademark Official Gazette*, and Opposer subsequently filed timely extensions of time to oppose and the instant opposition.

Count I: Likelihood of Confusion, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d)

23. Opposer repeats and realleges each and every allegation set forth above.

24. Opposer has priority based on its prior use of its SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark in commerce on or in connection with Opposer's Goods and Services. Opposer has used its SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark in commerce in connection with Opposer's Goods and Services before the filing date of the opposed Application Serial No. 85483515, and any date of first use that may be alleged by Applicant. Further, Opposer has priority based on its valid and subsisting pleaded registration for its SABRETOOTH mark.

25. Applicant's SABERTOOTH mark is virtually identical in sound, appearance, and connotation to Opposer's SABRETOOTH name and mark. Indeed, the marks differ by only the transposition of the letters "RE" to "ER" in the middle of the marks. Consumers are unlikely to notice this slight difference between the marks because the marks have the identical pronunciation and connotation, and are virtually identical in appearance.

26. Applicant's goods are closely related to Opposer's Goods and Services advertised, promoted, offered, and/or sold by Opposer in connection with its SABRETOOTH character, name, and mark.

27. Accordingly, Applicant's SABERTOOTH mark shown in Application Serial No. 85483515 so resembles Opposer's previously used and registered SABRETOOTH

character, name, and mark set forth above as to be likely, when used in connection with Applicant's goods, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive under Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

Count II: Void ab Initio

28. Opposer repeats and realleges each and every allegation set forth above.

29. On information and belief, Applicant does not now and has never used the SABERTOOTH mark in commerce on or in connection with any of the goods listed in The SABERTOOTH Application.

30. On information and belief, Applicant had not used the SABERTOOTH mark in commerce on or in connection with any of the goods listed in The SABERTOOTH Application as of the November 30, 2011 filing date of the used-based application under Section 1(a), 15 U.S.C. § 1051(a), or the 2002 date of first use alleged therein.

31. Accordingly, the SABERTOOTH Application is void ab initio, should not have been approved for publication, and should not be allowed to register because Applicant was not using the SABERTOOTH mark in commerce in connection with any of the goods listed in the application as of the filing date of the application and continuing to date as required under Sections 1(a) and 45, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1051(a) and 1127.

WHEREFORE, Opposer believes that it is being damaged, and will be damaged, by the registration of the mark shown in Application Serial No. 85483515, and requests that the opposition be sustained, and that registration to Applicant be refused.
