Applicant's consented motion (filed February 22, 2016) to extend disclosure, discovery and trial dates by sixty days because the parties are unable to complete discovery under the current trial schedule is **GRANTED**. Trademark Rule 2.127(a).

In view thereof, trial dates are reset as follows:

Plaintiff's Pretrial Disclosures Due	6/4/2016
Plaintiff's 30-day Trial Period Ends	7/19/2016
Defendant's Pretrial Disclosures Due	8/3/2016
Defendant's 30-day Trial Period Ends	9/17/2016
Plaintiff's Rebuttal Disclosures Due	10/2/2016
Plaintiff's 15-day Rebuttal Period Ends	11/1/2016

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony, together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

As a final matter, to the extent the parties seek another extension of the deadline for discovery, the parties must file their extension request by employing the “general filings form” option and not the “consented motions” filing option and explain *in detail* why a further extension of the discovery period is warranted.¹ The Board notes that it has already provided the parties ample time to conclude discovery in this matter and, therefore, any further request to extend the close of discovery must be substantiated by a demonstration of good cause for the extension, whether consented to or not.

¹ If the parties file a consented request to extend the close of discovery by employing the “consented motions form” option in ESTTA, **the motion will be summarily denied for failing to comply with this order.**
