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**NOTICE OF OPPOSITION**

Opposer, Mappin & Webb Limited believes that it will be damaged by the registration of Applicant M Webb, LLC's M WEBB mark shown in Application Serial No. 85460569, and hereby opposes the same. As grounds for its opposition, Opposer alleges the following, upon actual knowledge with respect to itself and its own acts, and upon information and belief as to other matters:

**Opposer and its MAPPIN & WEBB Name and Mark**

1. Opposer, Mappin & Webb Limited, is a corporation of the United Kingdom, having an address of Aurum House, 2 Elland Road, Braunstone, Leicester LE31TT, United Kingdom.

2. Since its founding over 200 years ago, Opposer has become known worldwide for its luxury goods products, including, but not limited to jewelry, watches, handbags, silverware, and other gift items.

3. Opposer's reputation for high-quality products has led to its relationship with the British monarchy beginning in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century when it was granted a royal warrant that has lasted to date. Today, Opposer holds two Royal Warrants as silversmiths to Her Majesty the Queen and His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales.

4. Opposer has used and extensively promoted its MAPPIN & WEBB Name and Mark for over a century.

5. Among its other products, Opposer's iconic 1950's MAPPIN & WEBB Lizard Kelly bag was, in its day, the epitome of English fashion and well-known worldwide. That famous handbag remains in high demand today; a vintage MAPPIN & WEBB Lizard Kelly bag continues to command high prices and loyal following of collectors.

6. Opposer offers its luxury goods products to consumers in the U.S. through its website, [www.mappinandwebb.com](http://www.mappinandwebb.com).

8. Applicant M Webb, LLC is a Limited Liability Company of New York with an address of 56 East 13<sup>th</sup> Street, New York, New York 10003.

9. Applicant is the listed owner of Intent-to-Use Application Serial No. 85460569, filed on October 31, 2011, for the mark M WEBB for “handbags, purses, wallets, tote bags” in International Class 18 and “women's apparel and accessories, namely, shirts, t-shirts, pants, dresses, skirts, shorts, jackets, coats, sweaters, lingerie, pajamas, robes, socks, hosiery, scarves, gloves, hats, belts and footwear” in Class 25.

**Likelihood of Confusion, 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d)**

10. Opposer repeats and realleges each and every allegation set forth in the above paragraphs.

11. Opposer has priority based on its prior-filed applications.

12. Applicant's M WEBB mark is confusingly similar in sound, appearance, and connotation to Opposer's MAPPIN & WEBB Name and Mark. Further, Applicant seeks to register the M WEBB mark for goods that are highly related to the goods and services of Opposer.


13. 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
