

NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Opposer, Deutsche Telekom AG (hereinafter “DTAG”), believes that it will be damaged by registration of the stylized “t” mark in application Serial No. 85/883,597 (“the Contested Application”) for use in connection with “*Communication services, namely, transmission of voice, audio, visual images and data by telecommunications networks, wireless communication networks, the Internet, information services networks and data networks*” in International Class 38. Accordingly, DTAG hereby opposes the same pursuant to Section 13(a) of the Trademark Act of 1946, as amended (the Lanham Act), 15 U.S.C. § 1063(a).

The Parties and the Marks

1. DTAG is a corporation organized under the laws of the Federal Republic of Germany, with its principal place of business located at Friedrich-Ebert-Allee 140, Bonn, Germany 53113.

2. DTAG and its affiliates are one of the world’s largest providers of mobile telephone, telecommunication, and information technology goods and services. Both DTAG and

its affiliates, including T-Mobile USA Inc., T-Venture, T-Systems, N.A., and Telekom Innovation Laboratories (T-Labs), offer a broad range of mobile telephone, telecommunication, and information technology goods and services under DTAG's family of "T" marks, including the letter "T" itself, the "T" logo, the "t@" logo, "T-MOBILE," "T-SYSTEMS," and other "T" formatives (collectively, the "DTAG Marks"). These DTAG Marks are among DTAG's core brands and are integral to its corporate identity. In this regard, DTAG has extensively used and promoted the DTAG Marks in domestic and international commerce. Indeed, these marks have been widely used and registered by DTAG on a worldwide basis for many years in a stand-alone form, as a stand-alone design element, in combination with additional words, numbers, designs and/or device elements, in numerous colors, and in black and white. (See Exhibit A for a non-exhaustive, representative sample of the DTAG Marks in the United States). As a result of this extensive use, advertising, and promotion, the DTAG Marks have become well-known as distinctive indicators of the origin of DTAG's goods and services and have become a valuable symbol of DTAG's goodwill.

3. The DTAG Marks constitute a series or family of marks that are owned by and are in the name of DTAG or its affiliates, are well-known trademarks, and are subject to a number of trademark applications and registrations worldwide, many of which are now incontestable under 15 U.S.C. § 1065. (See Exhibit A).

4. Upon information and belief, the applicant, Mr. Constantin Dumitrescu ("Applicant" or "Mr. Dumitrescu"), is an individual with an address at 28 Bedford Avenue, Westbury, New York 11590 USA.

5. Mr. Dumitrescu's stylized "t" mark in the "Contested Application" fully incorporates the dominant distinctive element of the famous DTAG Marks and is identical to various DTAG Marks in sight, sound, and commercial impression.

6. The services in Mr. Dumitrescu's application are also identical to the services offered by DTAG in connection with the DTAG marks. In his application, Mr. Dumitrescu claims the following services in Class 38: "*Communication services, namely, transmission of voice, audio, visual images and data by telecommunications networks, wireless communication networks, the Internet, information services networks and data networks.*" This is a very broad description of telecommunication services that overlaps with the many telecommunication and information technology services provided by DTAG for many years.

7. Also, there is no question that DTAG has priority based on its senior use of the DTAG Marks and its valid and subsisting registrations for the DTAG Marks. DTAG's rights in its DTAG Marks date back to at least as early as August 24, 1995, the filing dates for U.S. Reg. Nos. 2,472,584 and 2,508,277. (See Exhibit A). Since this time, DTAG has continuously used its DTAG Marks and various other formatives of the "T" in U.S. and international commerce. On the other hand, Mr. Dumitrescu filed the Contested Application on March 22, 2013, and, on information and belief, he has not started using his mark in U.S. commerce.

Likelihood of Confusion with DTAG's Prior Registrations (Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d))

8. DTAG repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation set forth in Paragraphs 1-7.

9. As shown in Exhibit A, several of the DTAG Marks are stylized versions of a lower-case letter "t" designed to resemble the "@" symbol (hereinafter, the "DTAG t@ Marks") (see, e.g., Reg. Nos. 2367890; 3373729; 3801161; 3629122; 3608020). Likewise, the mark in

the Contested Application is a lower-case letter “t” designed to resemble the “@” symbol. Accordingly, Mr. Dumitrescu’s mark is identical to the DTAG t@ Marks in sight, sound, and commercial impression. This is clear from a side-by-side comparison:

10. The identical nature of the DTAG Marks and Mr. Dumitrescu’s “t@” mark is particularly pronounced given the broad telecommunication services claimed in the Contested Application (i.e., “*Communication services, namely, transmission of voice, audio, visual images and data by telecommunications networks, wireless communication networks, the Internet, information services networks and data networks*” in International Class 38). These services are identical to the services DTAG provides in connection with all of the DTAG Marks including the DTAG t@ Marks. For example, DTAG’s registration for the DTAG t@ Mark displayed above (Reg. No. 2367890) covers “*Telecommunication services, namely, personal communications services, providing telecommunication connections to a global computer network*” in International Class 38.

11. Because Mr. Dumitrescu’s services are identical to DTAG’s services, his consumers and channels of trade are also identical.

12. Mr. Dumitrescu adopted his identical “t@” mark for identical services many years after DTAG’s established worldwide use and promotion of the DTAG Marks for its goods and services. Accordingly, on information and belief, Mr. Dumitrescu modeled his trademark filing after the branding strategy established by DTAG for the DTAG Marks.

13. Mr. Dumitrescu's adoption of an identical trademark in connection with identical services duplicates the DTAG Marks and DTAG's "T" branding strategy. As a result, Applicant's mark will inevitably lead consumers to mistakenly believe that DTAG is the source of Mr. Dumitrescu's services and that Mr. Dumitrescu is affiliated with, endorsed by, or sponsored by DTAG, all in violation of DTAG's rights in the DTAG Marks.

14. For the foregoing reasons, DTAG believes and alleges that it will be damaged by the registration of the Contested Application (Serial No. 85/883,597).

15. Accordingly, the Contested Application should be refused pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

Likelihood of Confusion with DTAG's Common Law Rights (Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d))

16. DTAG repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation set forth in Paragraphs 1-15.

17. DTAG uses the DTAG Marks, including the letter "T" as a standard character word mark, in connection with various mobile telephone, telecommunication, and information technology goods and services. Based on DTAG's widespread and continuous use of the DTAG Marks in U.S. commerce, the DTAG Marks clearly and unmistakably indicate to consumers that DTAG is the one and only source of such goods and services. Accordingly, DTAG owns strong common law trademark rights in its DTAG Marks, and DTAG has not abandoned these common law rights.

18. DTAG's rights in the DTAG Marks are well prior to the filing date of the Contested Application, and on information and belief, Mr. Dumitrescu has not yet started using

the mark in the Contested Application. DTAG therefore has priority based on its prior and subsisting use of the DTAG Marks.

19. Mr. Dumitrescu's "t@" mark is predominated by the letter "t" and contains accompanying stylization that does not detract from this clear "t" impression. The DTAG Marks feature the letter "T" in upper and lower case and in a variety of fonts, styles, sizes, and colors, but the predominant impression is always the letter "T". Consequently, the respective marks are highly similar—and, in some cases, identical—in sight, sound, and commercial impression.

20. The highly similar, if not identical, nature of the DTAG Marks and Applicant's "t@" mark in sight, sound, and commercial impression is particularly pronounced given the identical nature of the services claimed in the Contested Application.

21. As a result, the goods and services, the relevant consumers, and the channels of trade of the senior DTAG Marks and Applicant's "t@" mark are identical.

22. Mr. Dumitrescu adopted his "t@" mark years after DTAG's established use and promotion of the DTAG Marks and presumably after encountering the DTAG Marks in the marketplace. Consequently, on information and belief, Mr. Dumitrescu modeled his trademark filing after the branding strategy established by DTAG for the DTAG Marks.

23. Mr. Dumitrescu's junior use of an identical trademark for identical services overlaps and duplicates the DTAG Marks and DTAG's "T" branding strategy. Such use will inevitably lead consumers to mistakenly believe that DTAG is the source of Mr. Dumitrescu's services and that Mr. Dumitrescu is affiliated with, endorsed by, or sponsored by DTAG, all in violation of DTAG's rights in the DTAG Marks.

24. For the foregoing reasons, DTAG believes and alleges that it is being and will be damaged by the registration of the Contested Application (Serial No.85/883597).

25. Accordingly, the Contested Application should be refused pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

Trademark Dilution by Blurring (Section 43(c), 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c))

26. DTAG repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation set forth in Paragraphs 1-25.

27. Mr. Dumitrescu has applied to register a stylized “t@” mark that is identical to the DTAG Marks, which DTAG has used in U.S. commerce for at least 18 years.

28. The DTAG Marks are inherently distinctive and readily identify DTAG as the source of the goods and services that DTAG provides.

29. The distinctiveness of the DTAG Marks has been further fortified through DTAG’s long, continuous and prominent use of the DTAG Marks.

30. The DTAG Marks are famous due to the duration, extent and geographical reach of DTAG’s advertising, publicity and longstanding use. Indeed, the DTAG Marks are well-known and have a high degree of recognition amongst the consuming public in the U.S. and around the world.

31. The DTAG Marks became famous before Applicant’s first use of his “t@” mark. Mr. Dumitrescu applied for his “t@” mark based on an intent to use that mark in U.S. commerce, and he has not filed a Statement of Use. Even if Applicant has used his mark in U.S. commerce, the DTAG Marks were famous before such use commenced.

32. On information and belief, Mr. Dumitrescu was aware of the DTAG Marks when he applied to register the “t@” mark in the Contested Application.

33. Mr. Dumitrescu's application to register his "t@" mark and future use of that mark will impair the distinctiveness of the DTAG Marks and will cause irreparable injury to DTAG's business and reputation.

34. DTAG will be damaged by the registration of the mark in the Contested Application because such registration will support and assist Mr. Dumitrescu in the diluting use of his "t@" mark and will give color of rights to Mr. Dumitrescu, all in violation of DTAG's superior statutory and common law rights in the DTAG Marks to the detriment and harm of DTAG.

35. Accordingly, because Mr. Dumitrescu's use of his "t@" mark is likely to cause trademark dilution by blurring, the Contested Application should be refused pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).

WHEREFORE, DTAG respectfully requests that application Serial No. 85/883,597 be refused registration due to likelihood of confusion and dilution, and that judgment in the present opposition be entered in favor of DTAG and against Mr. Dumitrescu.
