Opposer's consented motion filed April 20, 2016 to extend disclosure, discovery and trial dates is granted. Trademark Rule 2.127(a).

However, no further extension or suspension requests will be granted in the absence of a detailed progress report on the status of the parties' settlement negotiations. Such a report must include when the parties discussed settlement, what issues were resolved, what issues remain to be resolved and a firm timetable for resolution. Failing which, any future motion may not be approved.

Trial dates are reset in accordance with Opposer's consented motion.¹

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.
