On March 1, 2016, the Board suspended proceedings and allowed Opposer twenty days to further amend its notice of opposition to re-plead its first fraud claim (alleging fraud in view of Opposer's use), failing which the current amended notice of opposition would become the operative pleading and the first fraud claim would be stricken.

On March 21, 2016, Opposer filed its amended notice of opposition with the Board. Accordingly, the amended notice of opposition is accepted and made Opposer's operative pleading moving forward.

Applicant is allowed until **April 30, 2016** to file its amended answer to the amended notice of opposition. Remaining trial dates are reset as indicated below.
