On March 29, 2016, Applicant refiled a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 79138749, with Opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment, Applicant seeks to amend the identification of goods in International Class 7 by adding the underlined wording as set forth below:

Bearings as parts of machines, all of the foregoing specifically intended for rolling element bearing applications except for use in connection with gas turbines and gas turbine applications, and except for use in connection with electric motor driven or gas turbine driven compressor packages applied in the oil and gas industry; machine parts, namely, bearing housings, all of the foregoing specifically intended for rolling element bearing applications except for use in connection with gas turbines and gas turbine applications, and except for use in connection with electric motor driven or gas turbine driven compressor packages applied in the oil and gas industry.

International Classes 9 and 42 remain as amended in the Board's order March 7, 2016.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because Opposer consents thereto, the amendment is approved and entered. *See* Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If the amendment resolves this proceeding, Opposer is allowed until thirty (30) days from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. *See* Trademark Rule 2.106(c).

If no response is filed, proceedings will be resumed and dates reset, as appropriate.

Proceedings are otherwise suspended.
