JOINT MOTION/STIPULATION TO EXTEND DEADLINES AND INTERROGATORIES



("Petitioner") and Respondent USAmeriBank ("Respondent") respectfully move under Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual of Procedure §§ 501 and 509 and stipulate to extend the deadlines as follows and to increase the number of interrogatories from 25 to 50:

Initial Disclosures:	February 26, 2016
Experts for Case in Chief:	August 5, 2016
Rebuttal Experts:	August 26, 2016
Discovery Closes:	September 30, 2016
Plaintiff's Pretrial Disclosures:	November 4, 2015
Plaintiff's Trial Period Ends:	November 14, 2016 – December 16, 2016 (Plaintiff may begin its trial period on November 14, 2016, but the parties have agreed not to take testimony during the week of Thanksgiving)
Defendant's Pretrial Disclosures:	January 13, 2017
Defendant's Trial Period:	February 27, 2017
Plaintiff's Rebuttal Disclosures:	March 13, 2017
Plaintiff's Rebuttal Period Ends:	April 11, 2017

This joint motion is not sought for purposes of delay, but rather is the result of the parties' good faith discussions in the Discovery Conference and is intended to work around existing conflicts in the schedules of counsel.

Accordingly, the parties respectfully request that the deadlines be extended as requested and that the number of interrogatories be extended from 25 to 50.




