Motion to Amend

Now before the Board is Applicant's consented motion (filed September 9, 2016) to amend the subject application. Applicant did not submit a red-lined copy of the proposed amendment(s).

It is noted that the identification of goods and services which Applicant seeks to amend contains, collectively two classes. As explained in TBMP § 514.01:

The Board recommends submission of a red-lined copy of the proposed amendment showing the proposed changes along with a clean copy of the proposed amendment, particularly if a lengthy identification of goods is involved. Such a submission will assist Board personnel in entry of the amendment should the motion be granted.

In view of the identifications involved in the subject application and the Board's desire to accurately determine the merits of the motion to amend, Applicant is allowed until **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order in which to provide a red-lined version of the proposed amendment(s); failing which, the September 9, 2016 motion to amend will be given no consideration.¹
